
The Tariff Act of 1930 (the "Act"), as amended, in relevant part provides:

During any review under this subsection initiated 2 years or 4 years after the publication of an antidumping duty order under section 1673e (a) of this title, the administering authority, if requested, shall determine whether antidumping duties have been absorbed by a foreign producer or exporter subject to the order if the subject merchandise is sold in the United States through an importer who is affiliated with such foreign producer or exporter.<sup>2</sup>

Because the current administrative review was initiated on March 28, 2007,<sup>3</sup> two years after publication of the relevant antidumping duty order on February 1, 2005,<sup>4</sup> the Department must conduct the requested duty absorption inquiry if the respondent foreign producer or exporter is affiliated with the importer.
