Seized Mexican Shrimp Bid Package

Description of Product:

35,003 pounds of wild caught frozen large headless Mexican brown shrimp (Farfantepenaeus aztecus) packed in 442 plastic totes on twenty (20) pallets. The shrimp was imported from Tampico, Mexico. The shrimp was imported as ungraded 21-25 count.

Labeling Requirements:

All of the product must be labeled in a manner that identifies Mexico as the country of origin.

Details:

On October 31, 2012 the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) Office of Law Enforcement (OLE) seized the 35,000 pounds of shrimp currently being offered for sale. The shrimp is being held in cold storage in Baton Rouge, LA and has been inspected by the Department of Commerce, Seafood Inspection Program. All of the shrimp was found to be of good quality and condition at the time of the inspection. Certificates have been issued by the Seafood Inspection Program attesting to the results of the inspection (available upon request). All of the shrimp is being offered as one lot. There will be no splitting of the product. Payment is be in the form of a check made payable to the U.S. Department of Commerce.
