


Louisiana Landings, September 2002-2022 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

Texas Landings, September 2002-2022 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)



Alabama Landings, September 2002-2022 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)



West Coast of Florida Landings, September 2002-2022 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)




September average for the 2002-2021 period = 271,005 pounds

Mississippi Landings, September 2002-2022 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)



Gulf Landings, September 2002-2022 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)



Louisiana Landings, January-September 2002-2022 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)




January-September average for the 2002-2021 period = 36,290,830 pounds

Texas Landings, January-September 2002-2022 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)




January-September average for the 2002-2021 period = 27,534,670 pounds

Alabama Landings, January-September 2002-2022 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)




January-September average for the 2002-2021 period = 7,847,070 pounds

West Coast of Florida Landings, January-September 2002-2022 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)




January-September average for the 2002-2021 period = 4,489,815 pounds

Mississippi Landings, January-September 2002-2022 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)



East Coast of Florida Landings, September 2018-2022 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)



Georgia Landings, September 2018-2022 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)



North Carolina Landings, September 2018-2022 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)



South Carolina Landings, September 2018-2022 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)



South Atlantic Landings, September 2018-2022 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)



East Coast of Florida Landings, Jan.-Sept, 2018-2022 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)




January-September average for the 2018-2021 period = 2,944,450 pounds

Georgia Landings, Jan.-Sept. 2018-2022 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)




January-September average for the 2018-2021 period = 1,206,625 pounds

North Carolina Landings, Jan.-Sept. 2018-2022 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)




January-September average for the 2018-2021 period = 3,394,125 pounds

South Carolina Landings, Jan.-Sept. 2018-2022 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)




January-September average for the 2018-2021 period = 1,083,000 pounds

2022 Landings in South Atlantic Were 28.9% Below Historical Average




South Atlantic Landings, Jan.-Sept. 2018-2022 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)




January-September average for the 2018-2021 period = 8,628,150 pounds

September Ex-Vessel Prices 2018-2022 (U15)




September Ex-Vessel Prices 2018-2022 (15/20)





September Ex-Vessel Prices 2018-2022 (21/25)








