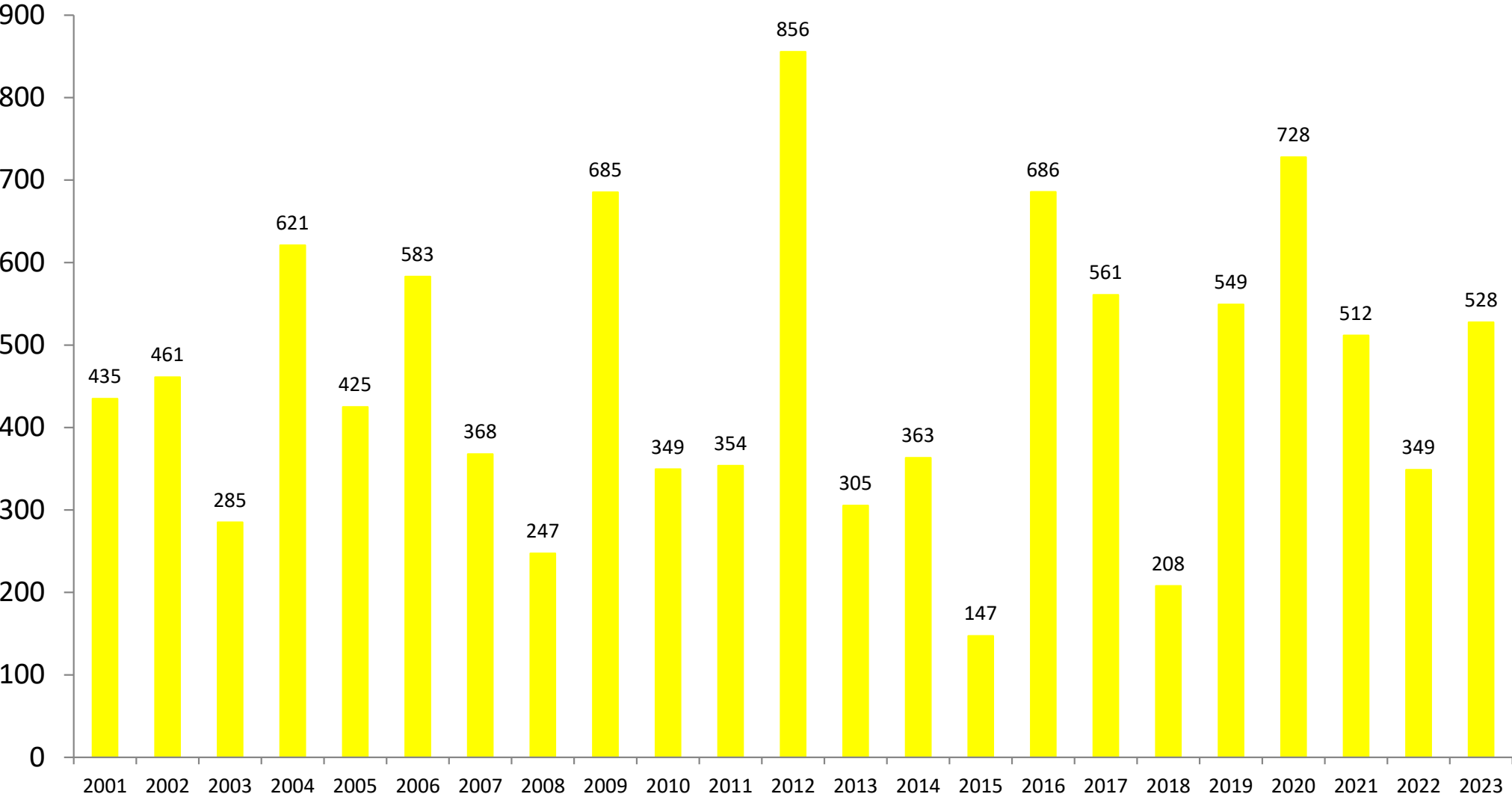

Louisiana Landings, March 2001-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

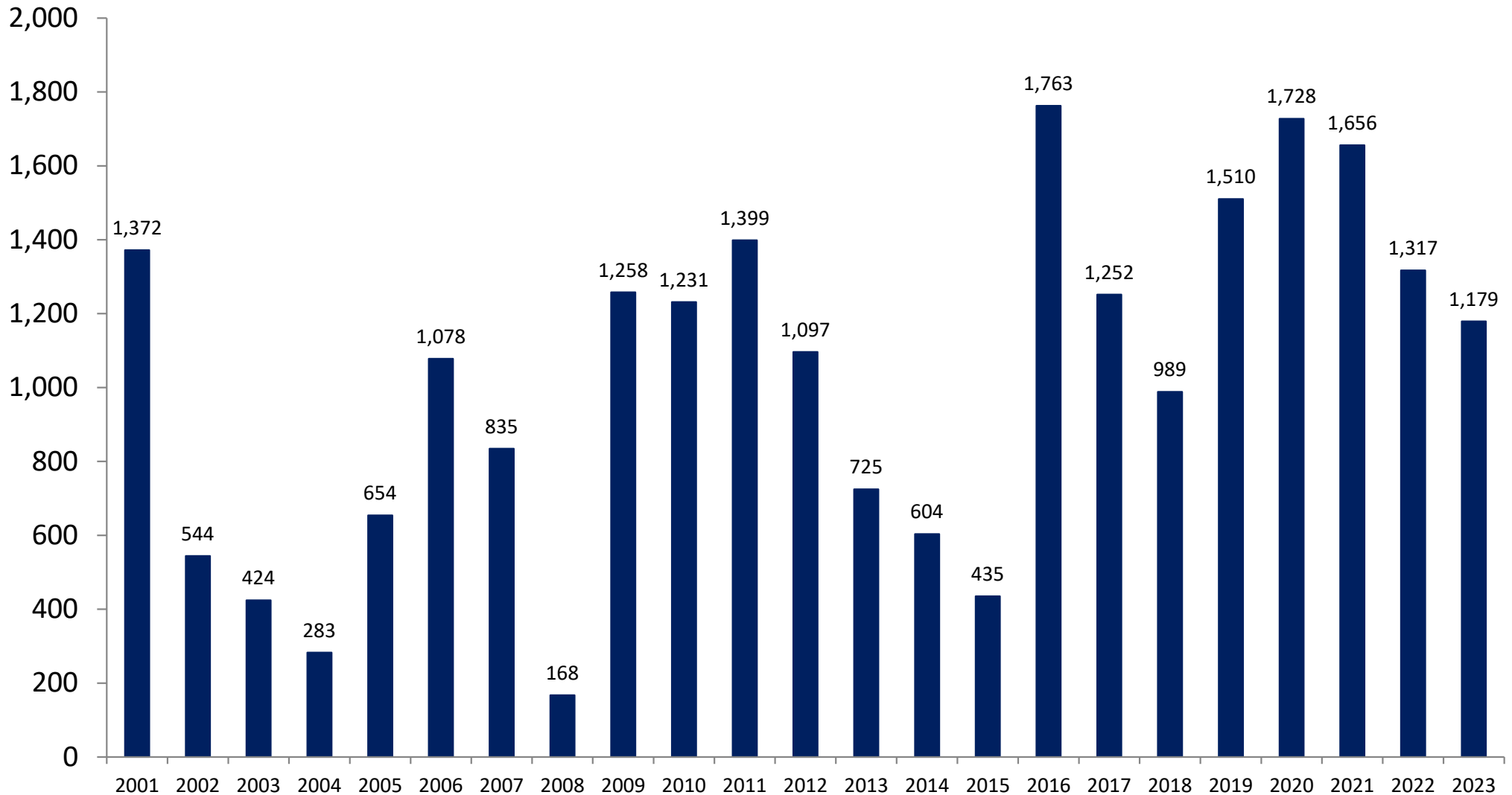

## Texas Landings, March 2001-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

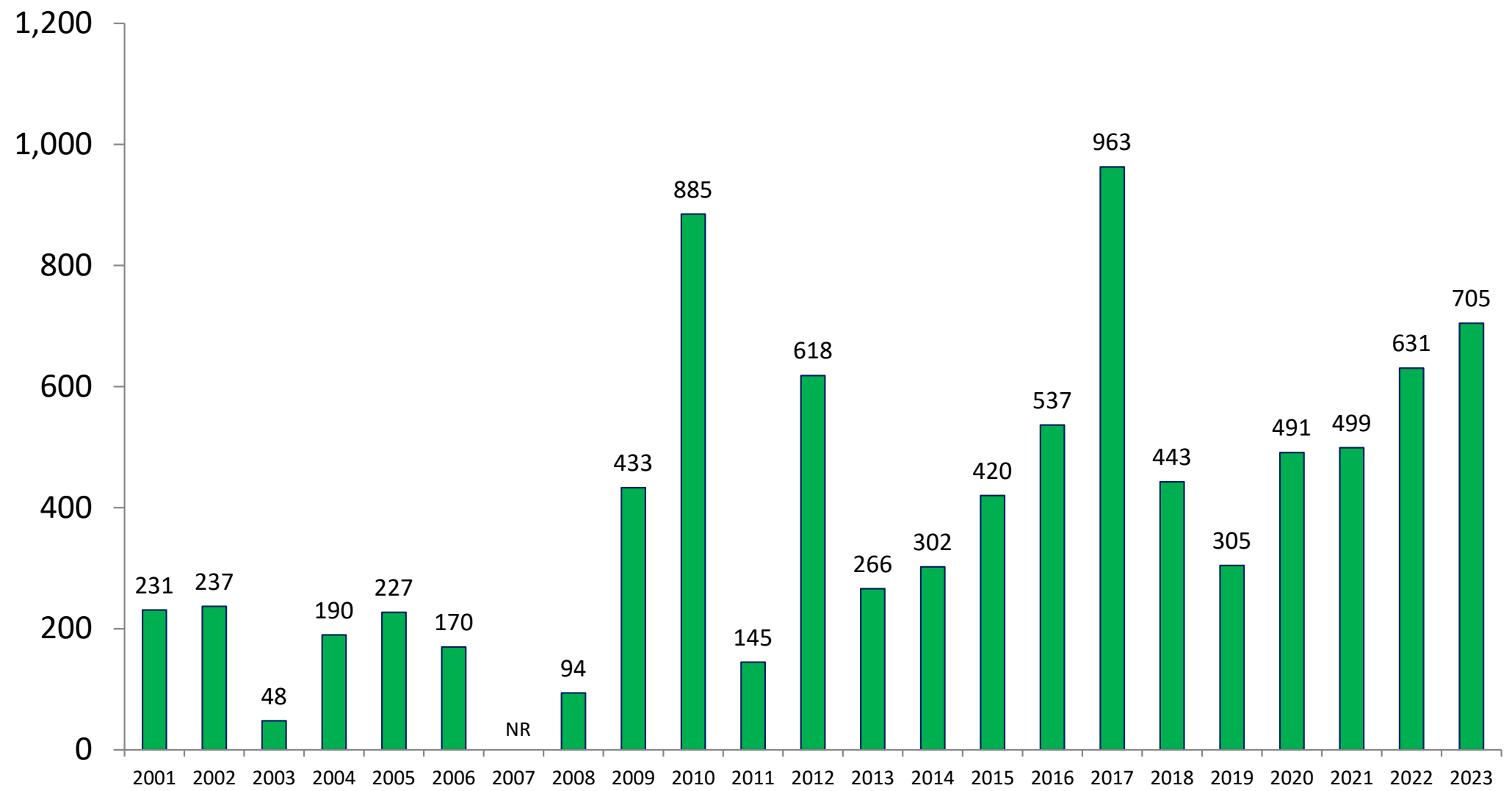

Alabama Landings, March 2001-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

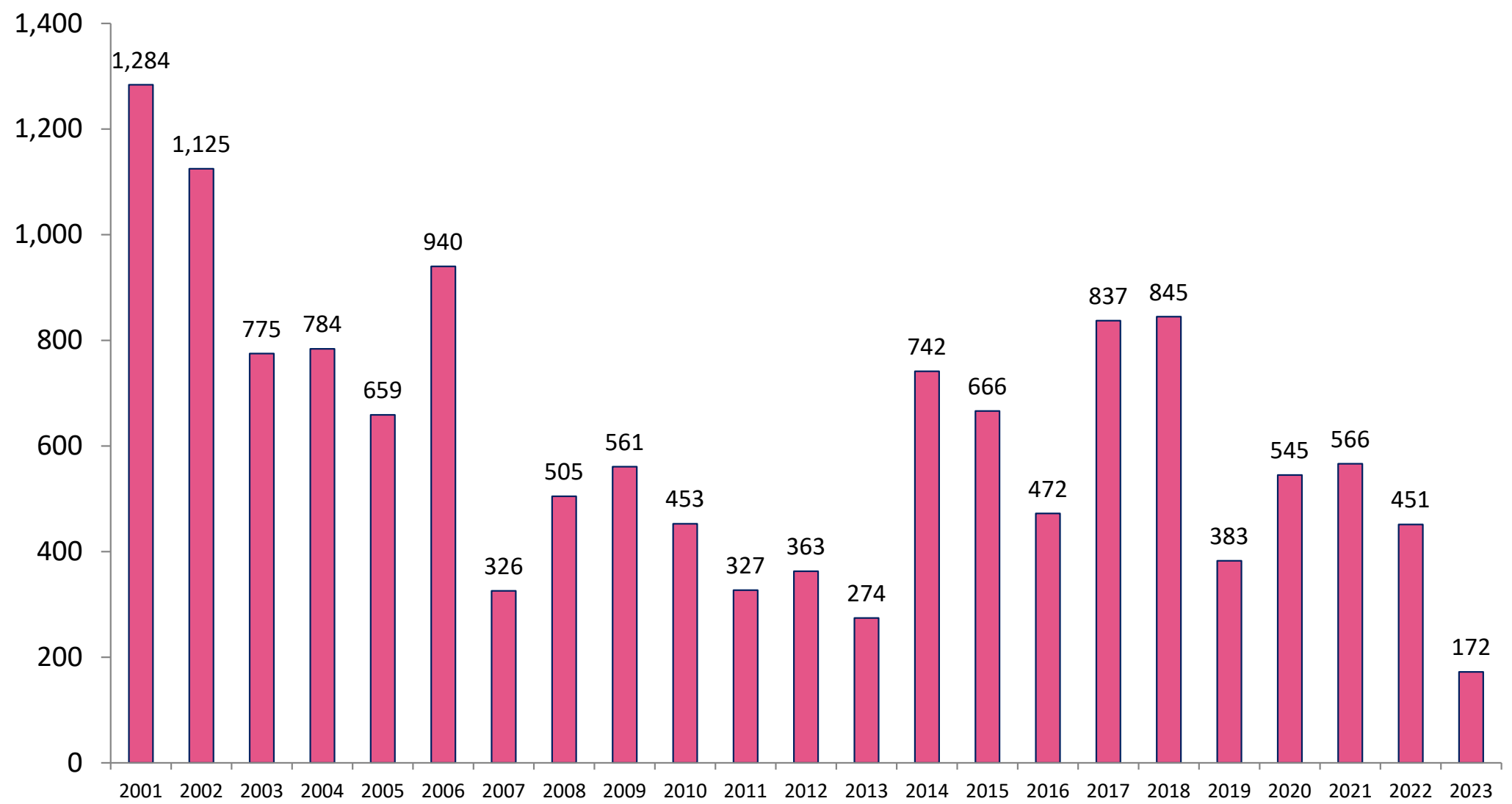

West Coast of Florida Landings, March 2001-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

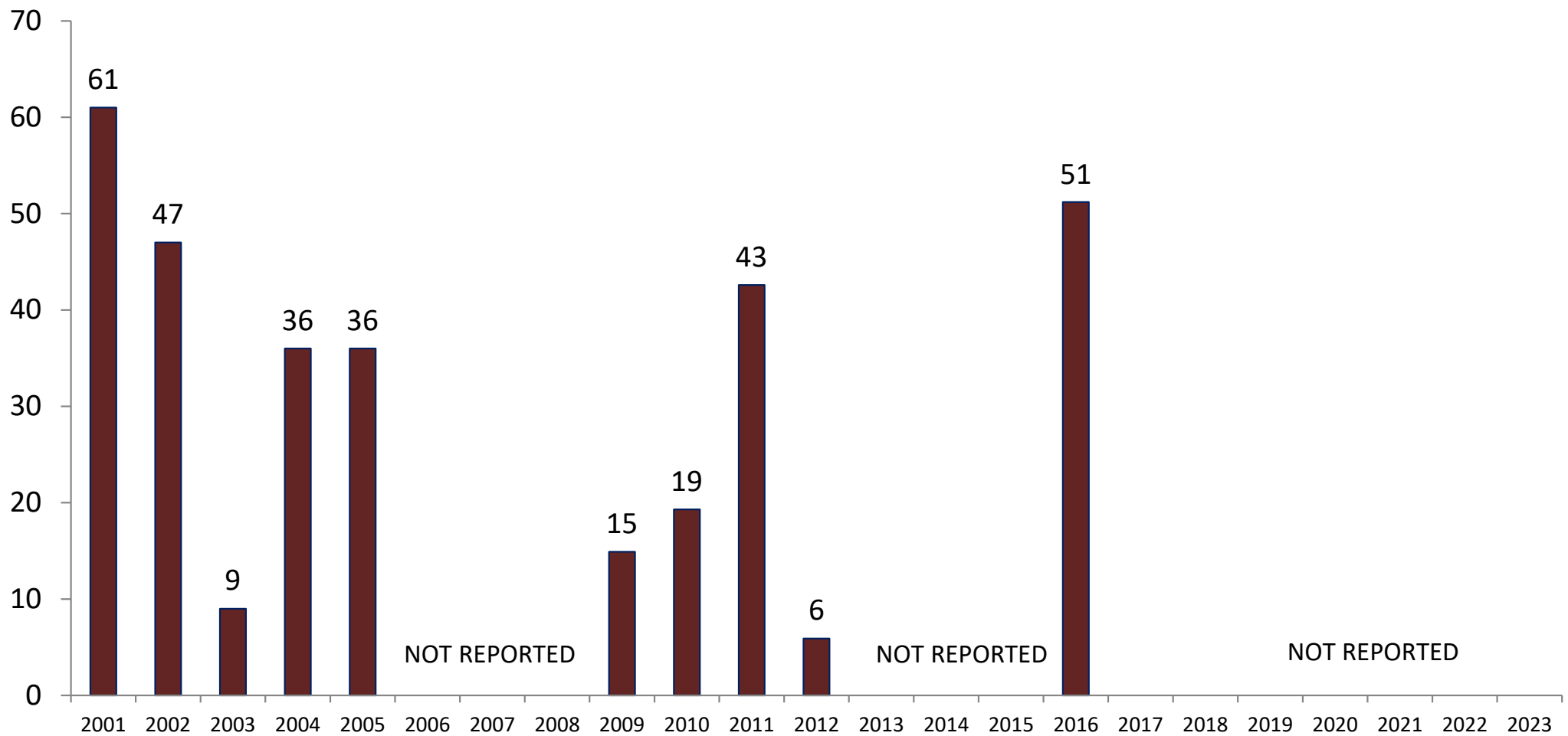

Mississippi Landings, March 2001-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

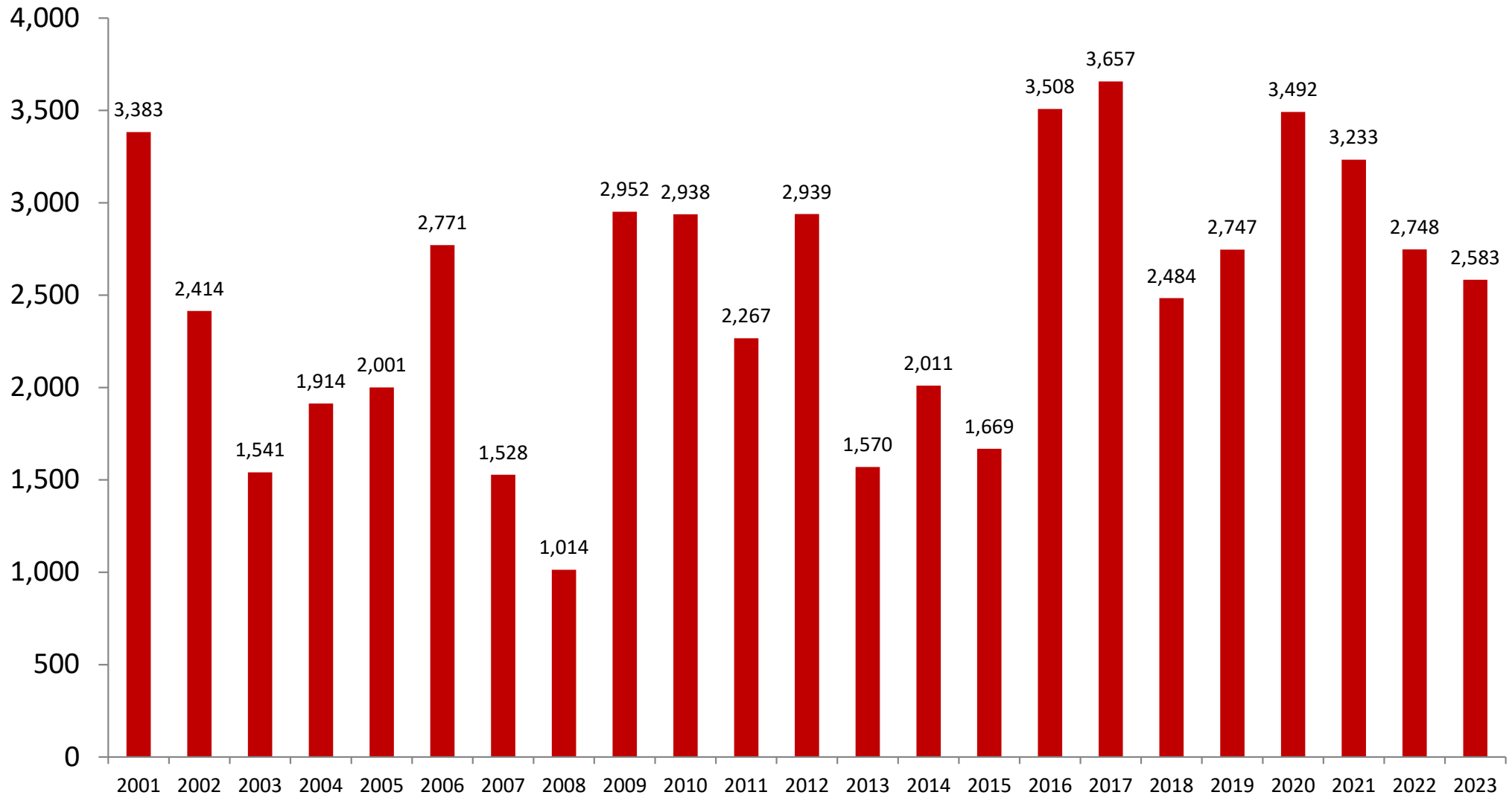

**Gulf Landings, March 2001-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)**

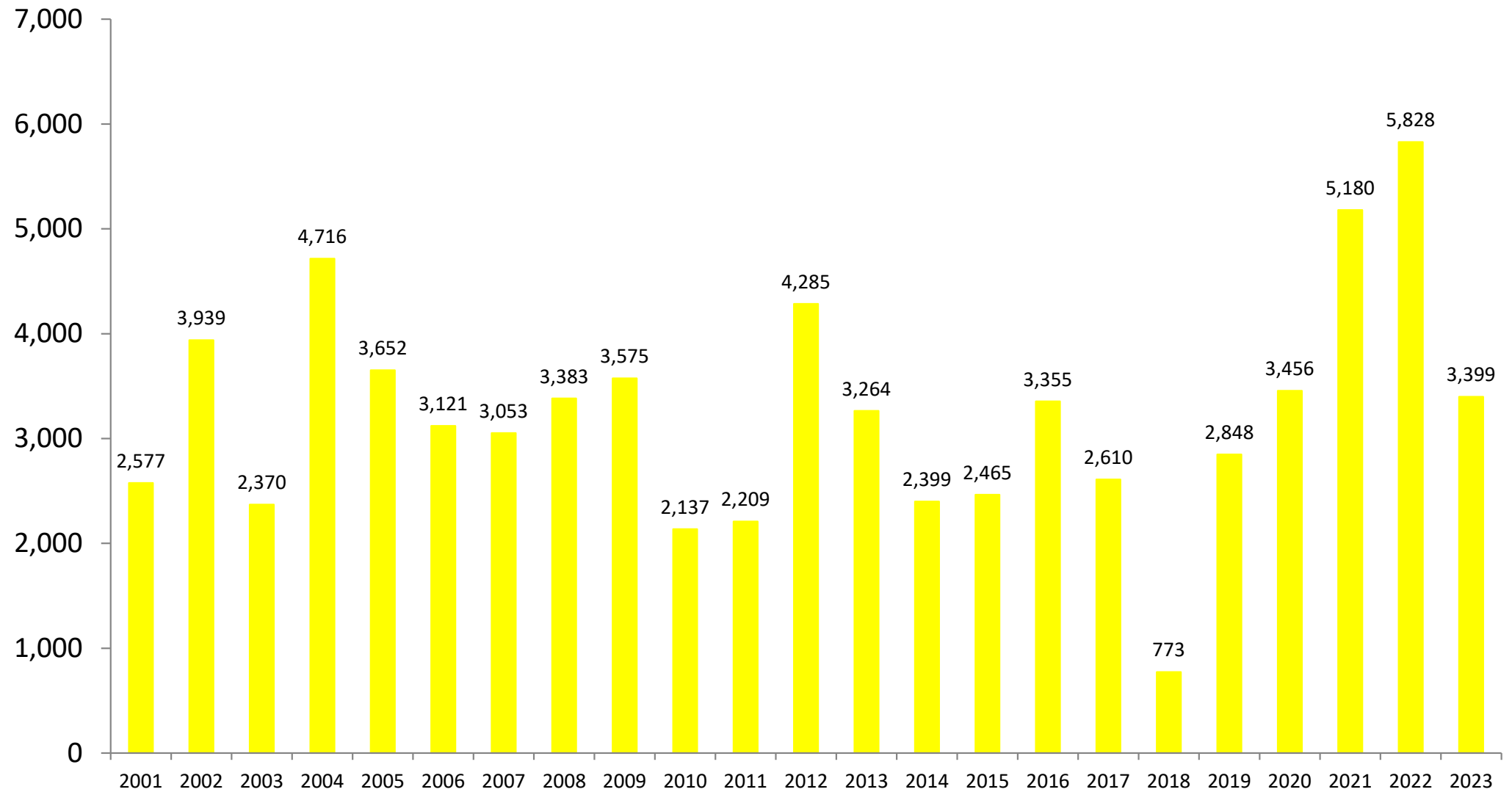

Louisiana Landings, January-March 2001-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

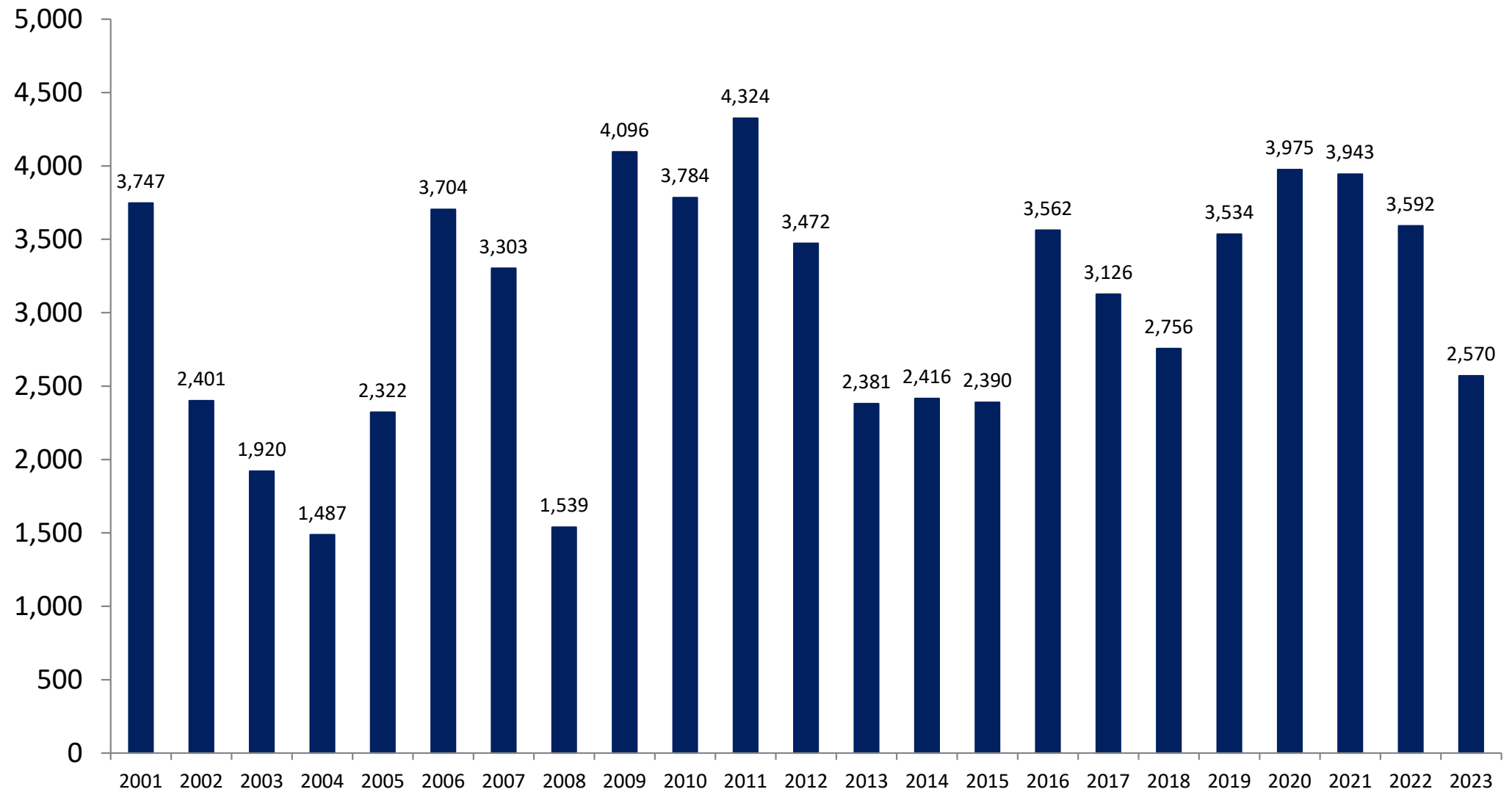

**Texas Landings, January-March 2001-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)**



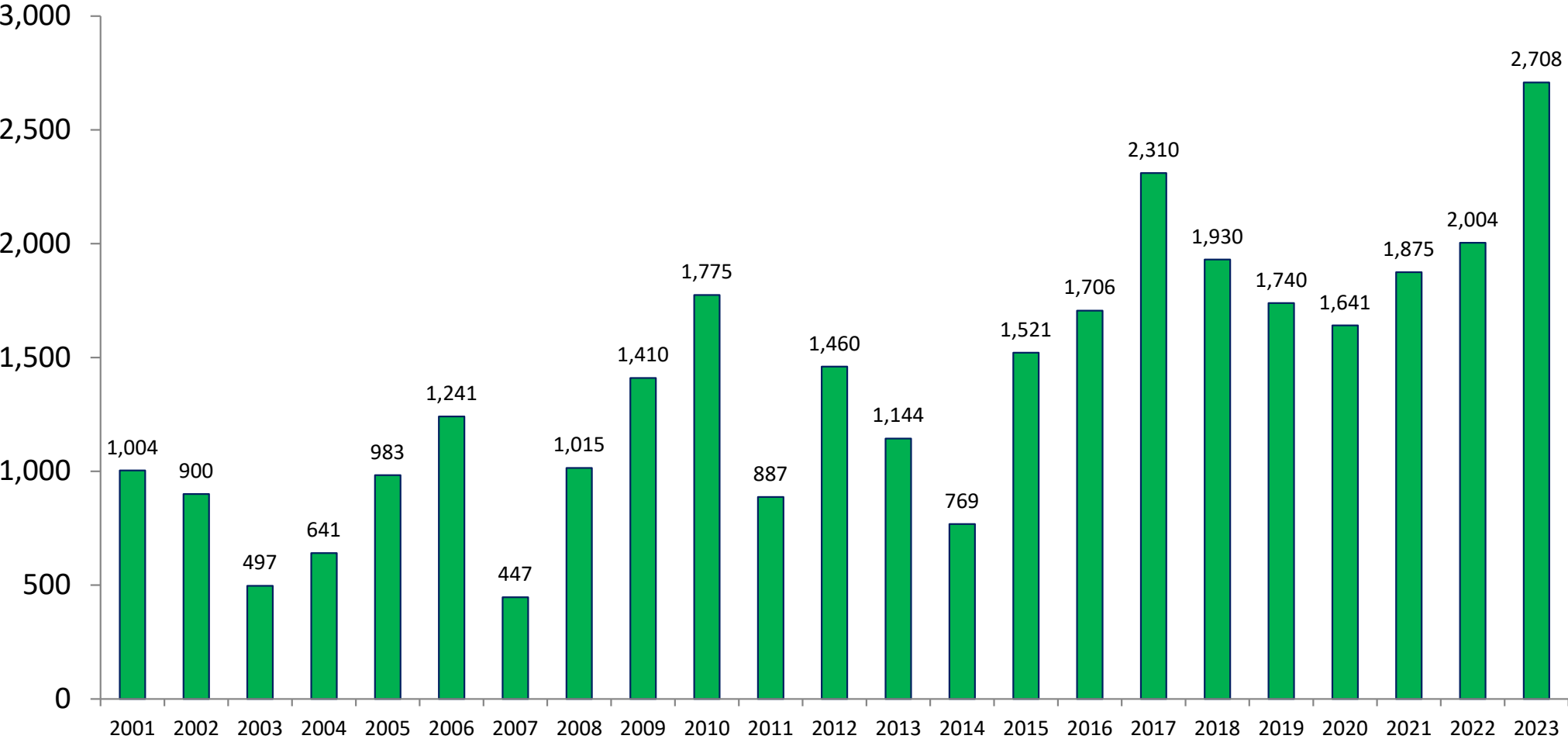

Alabama Landings, January-March 2001-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

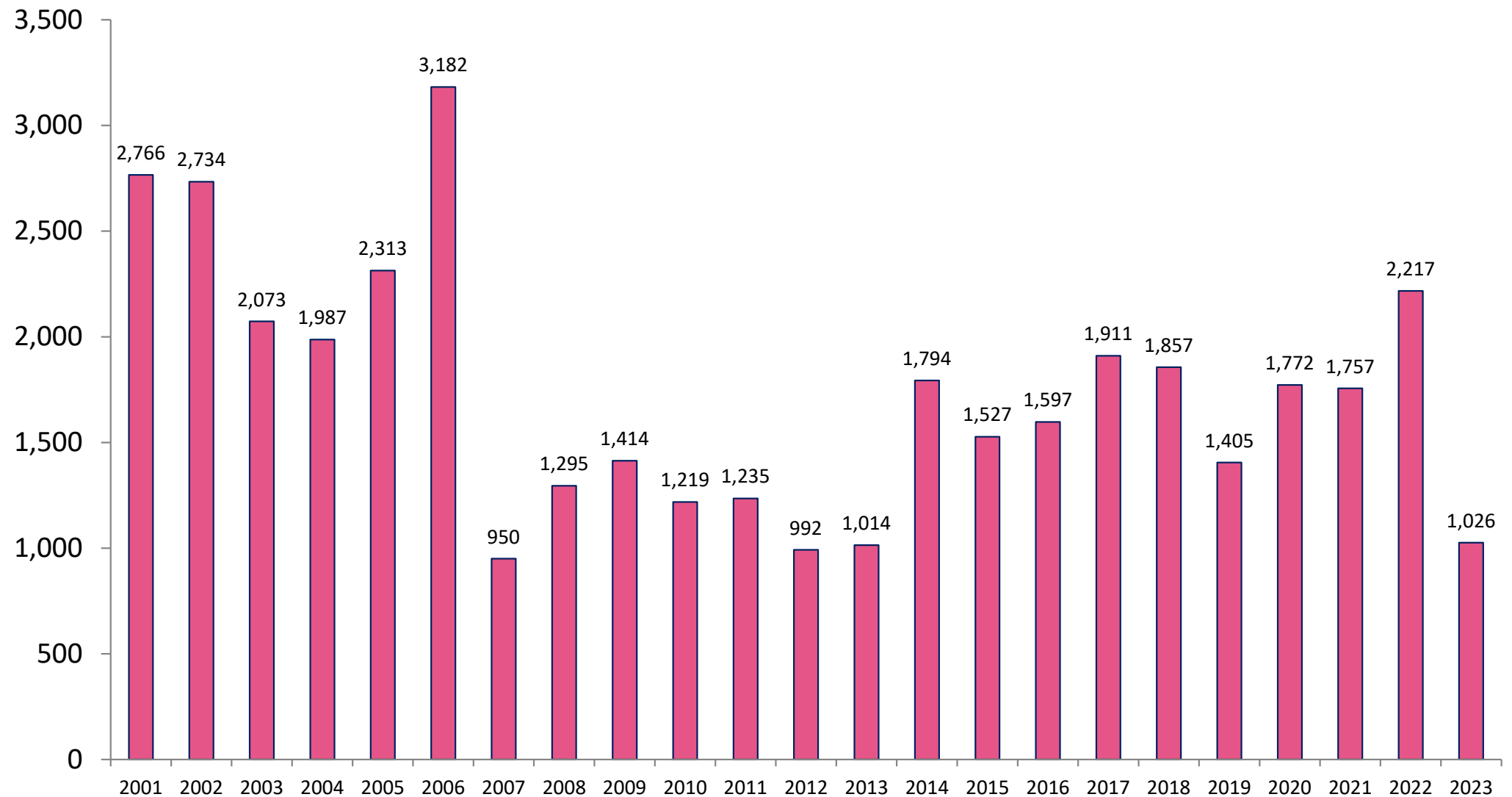

West Coast of Florida Landings, January-March 2001-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

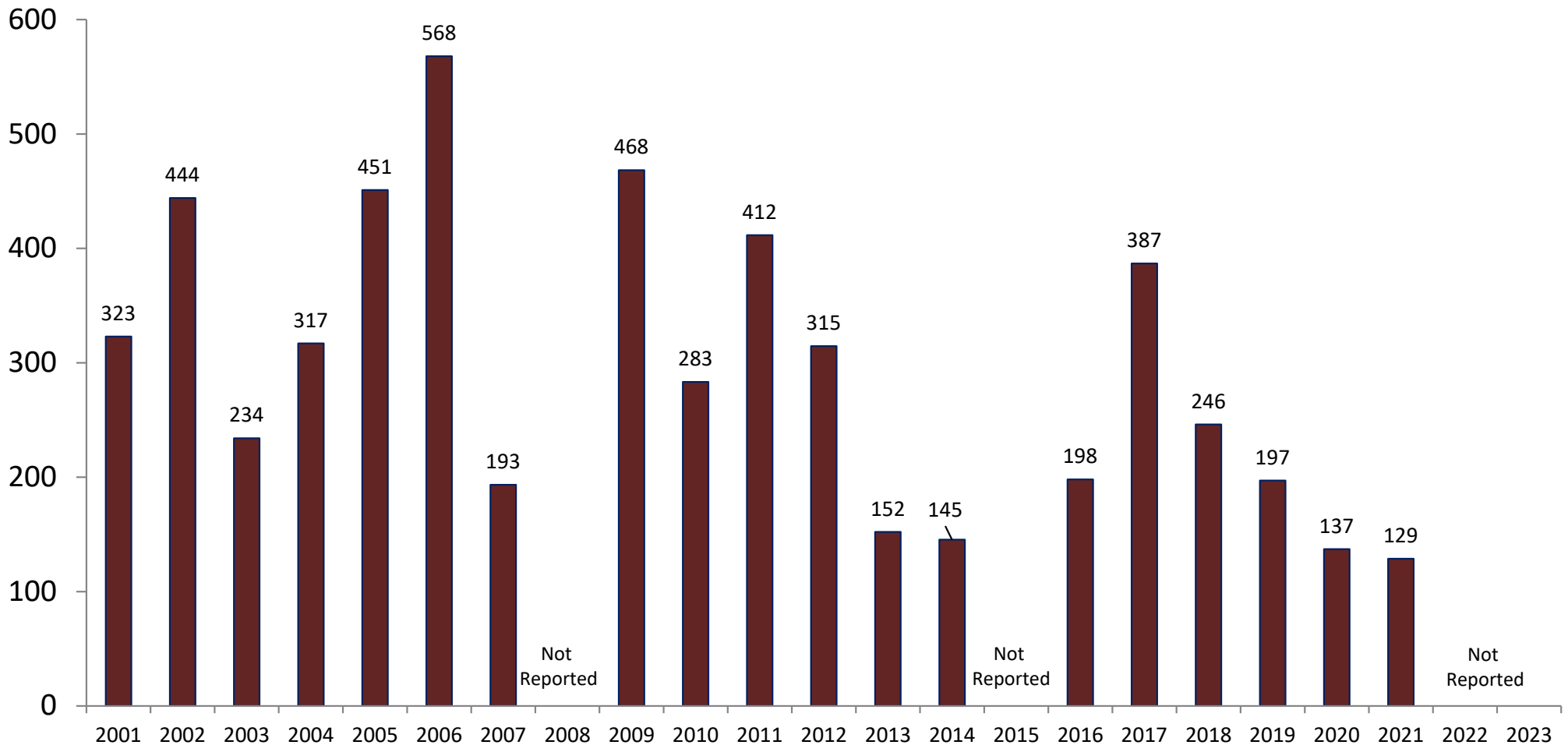

Mississippi Landings, January-March 2001-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

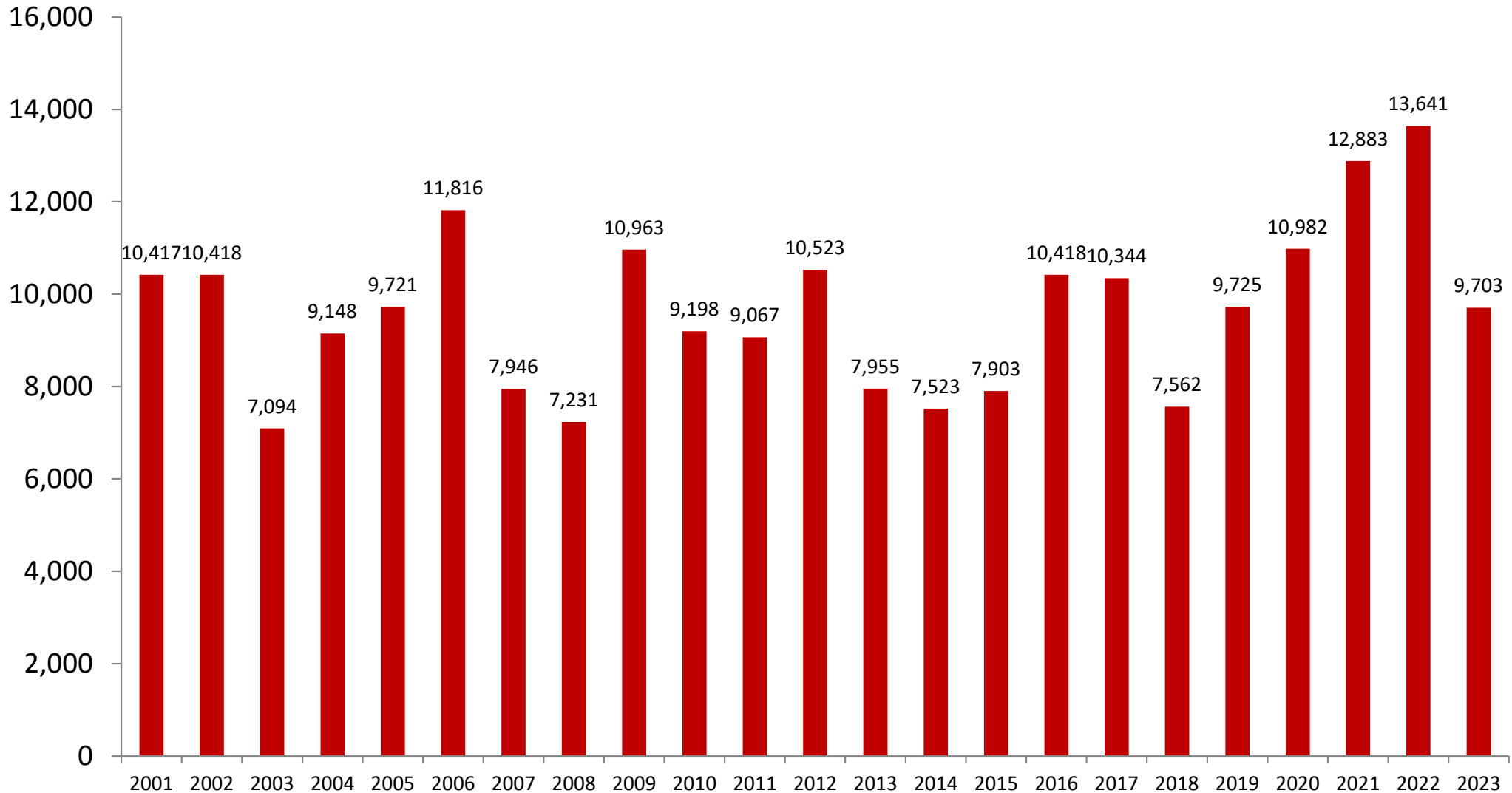

Gulf Landings, January-March 2001-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

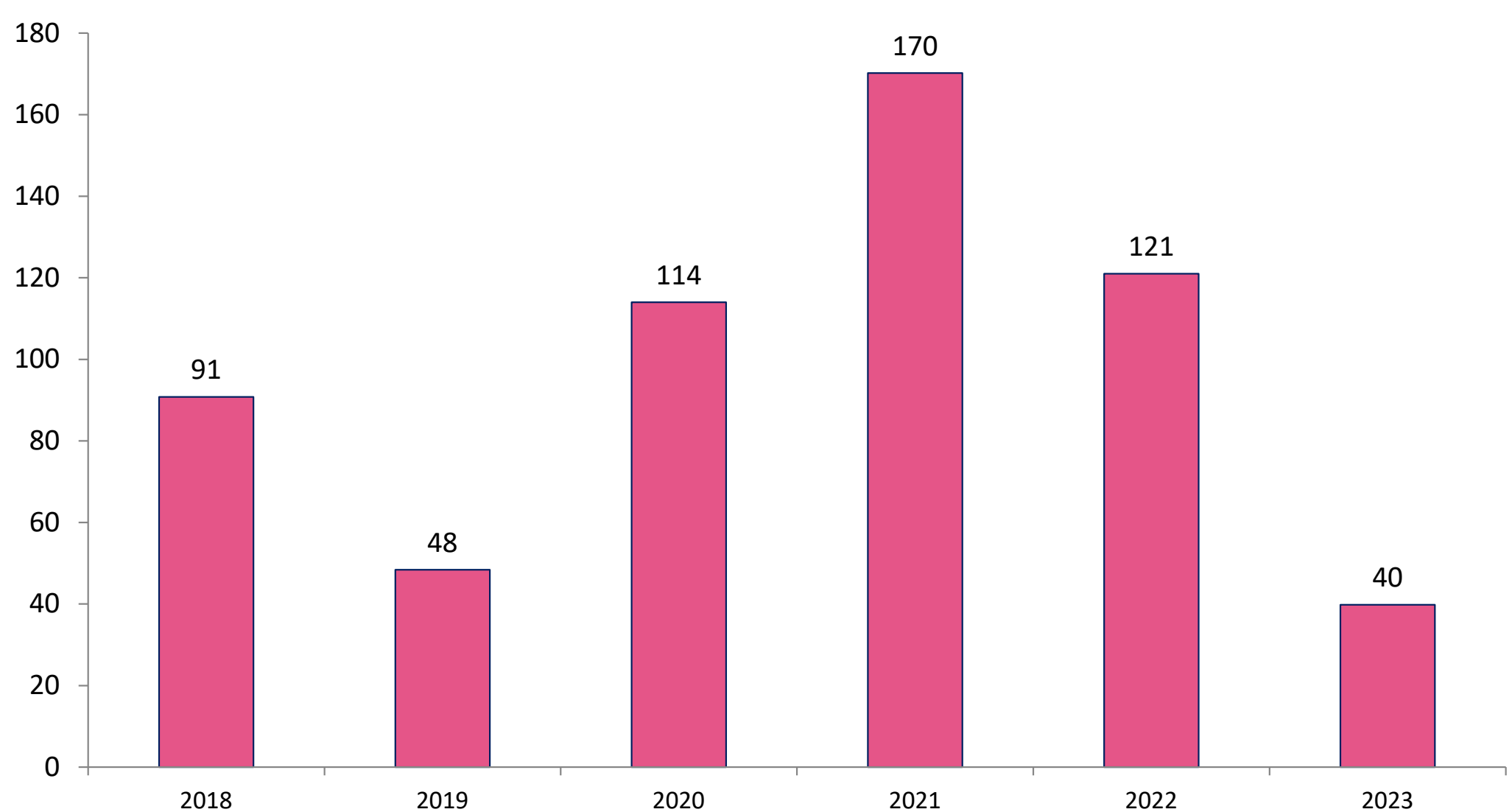

East Coast of Florida Landings, March 2018-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

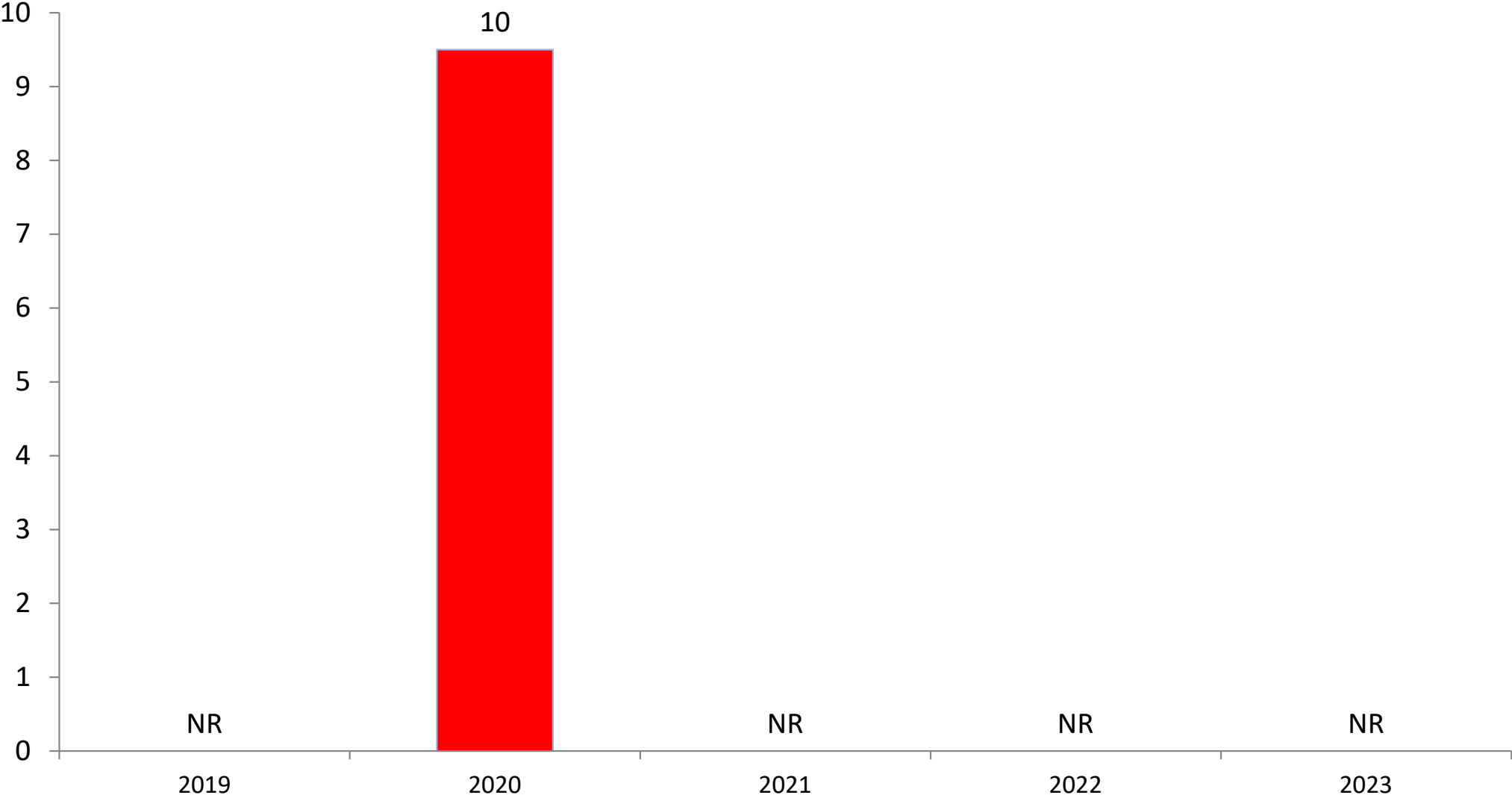

South Carolina Landings, March 2019-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

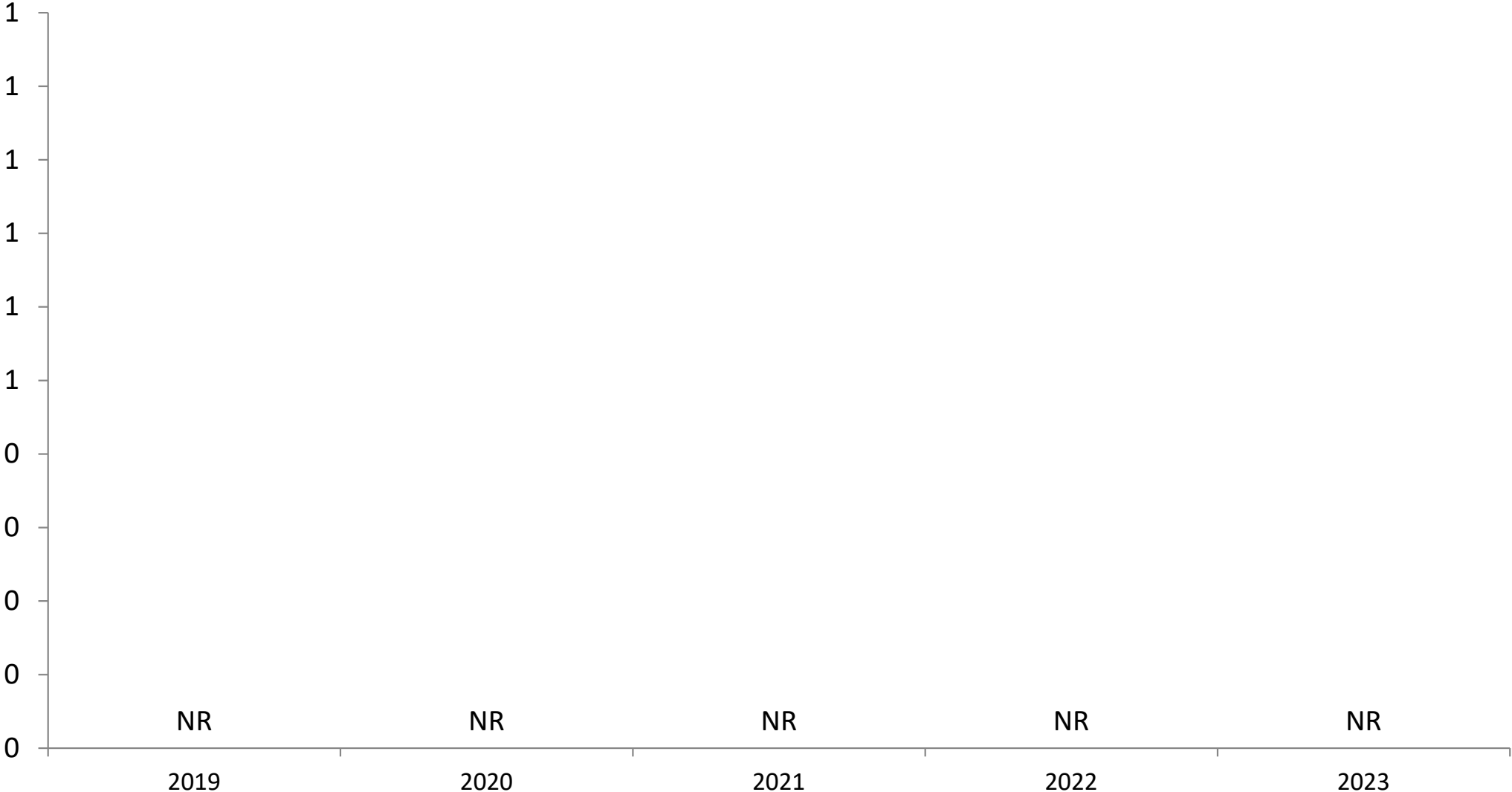

Georgia Landings, March 2019-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

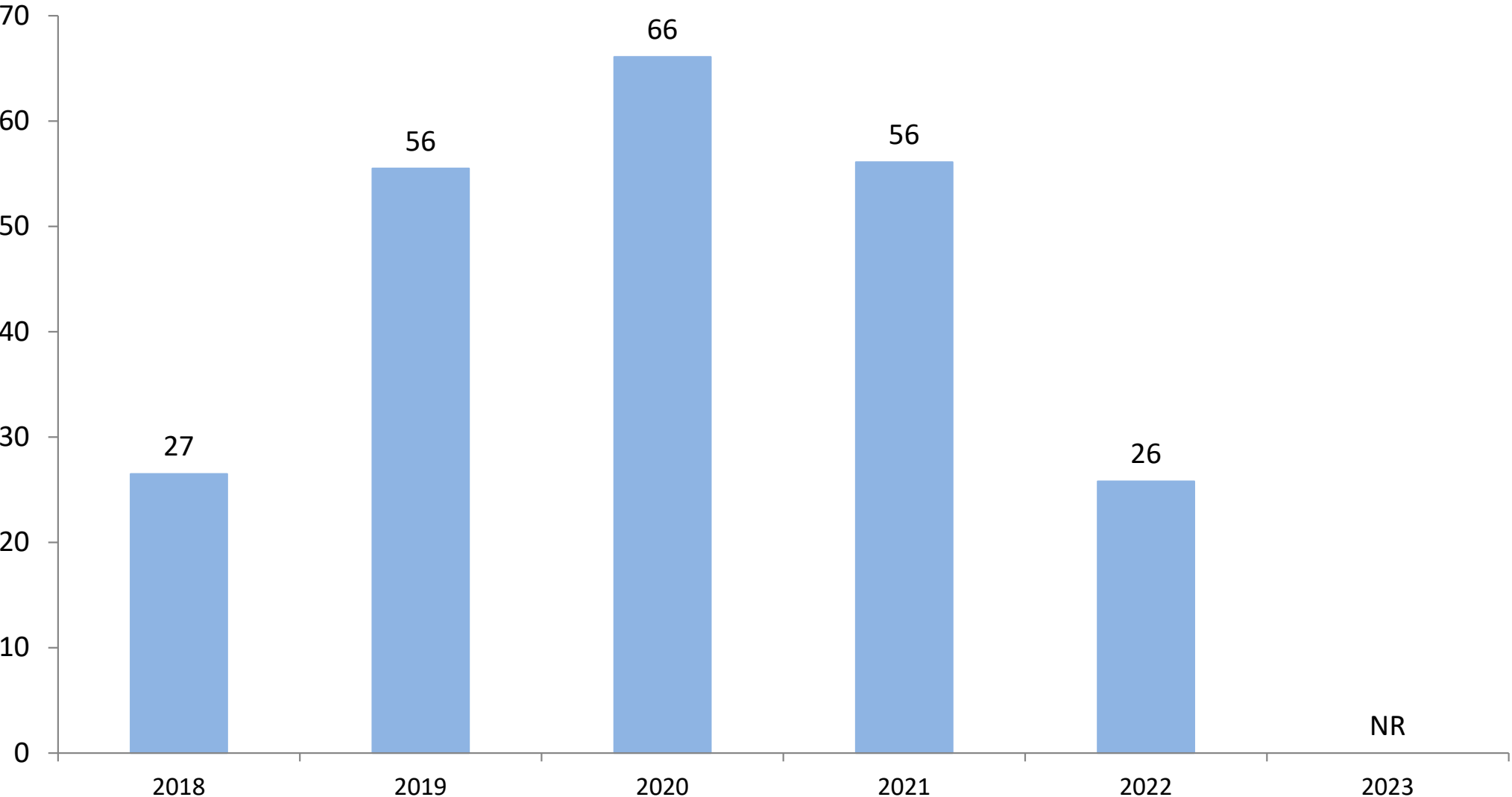

North Carolina Landings, March 2018-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)



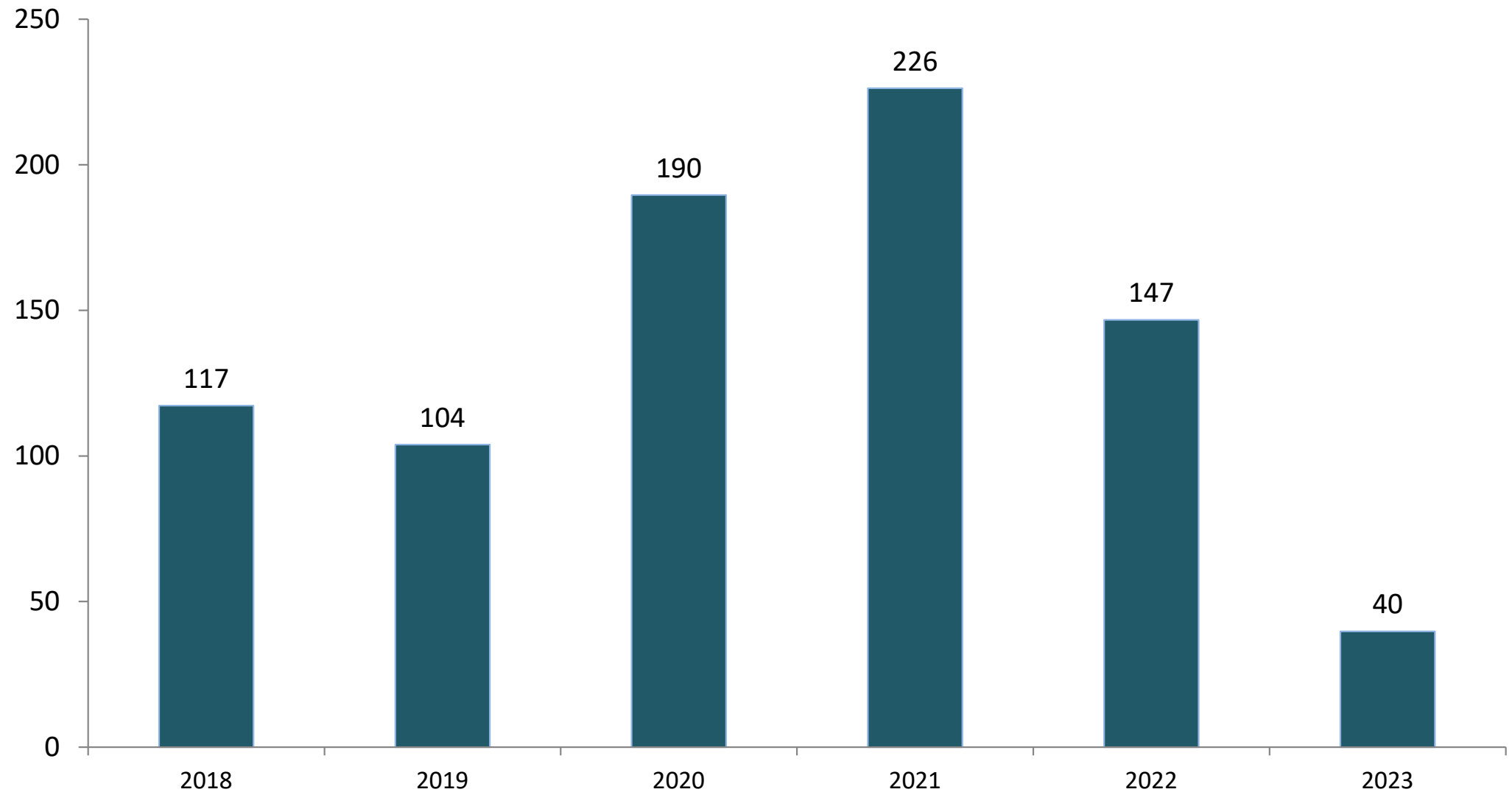

South Atlantic Landings, March 2018-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

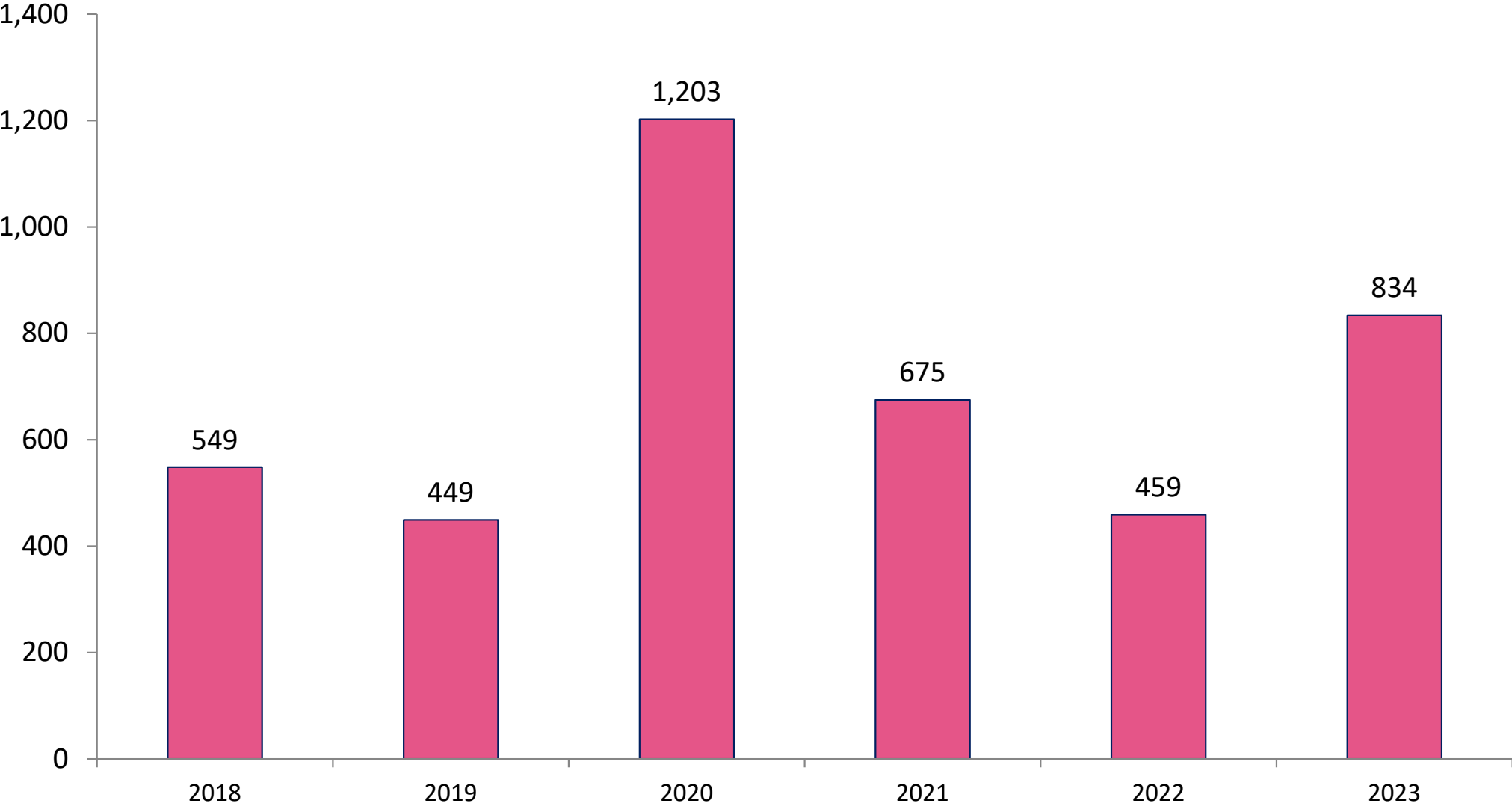

East Coast of Florida Landings, January-March 2018-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

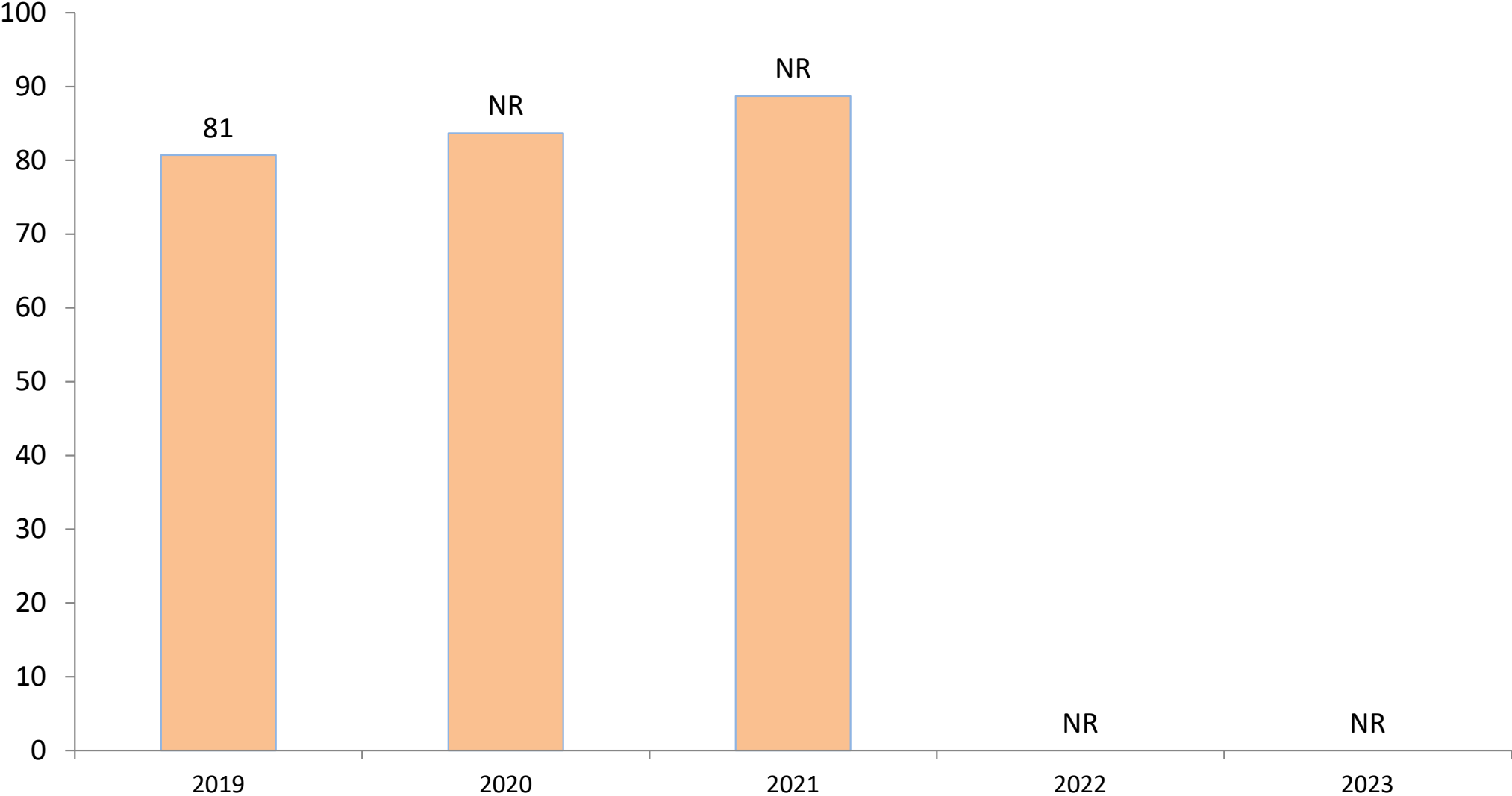

Georgia Landings, Jan.-Mar. 2019-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

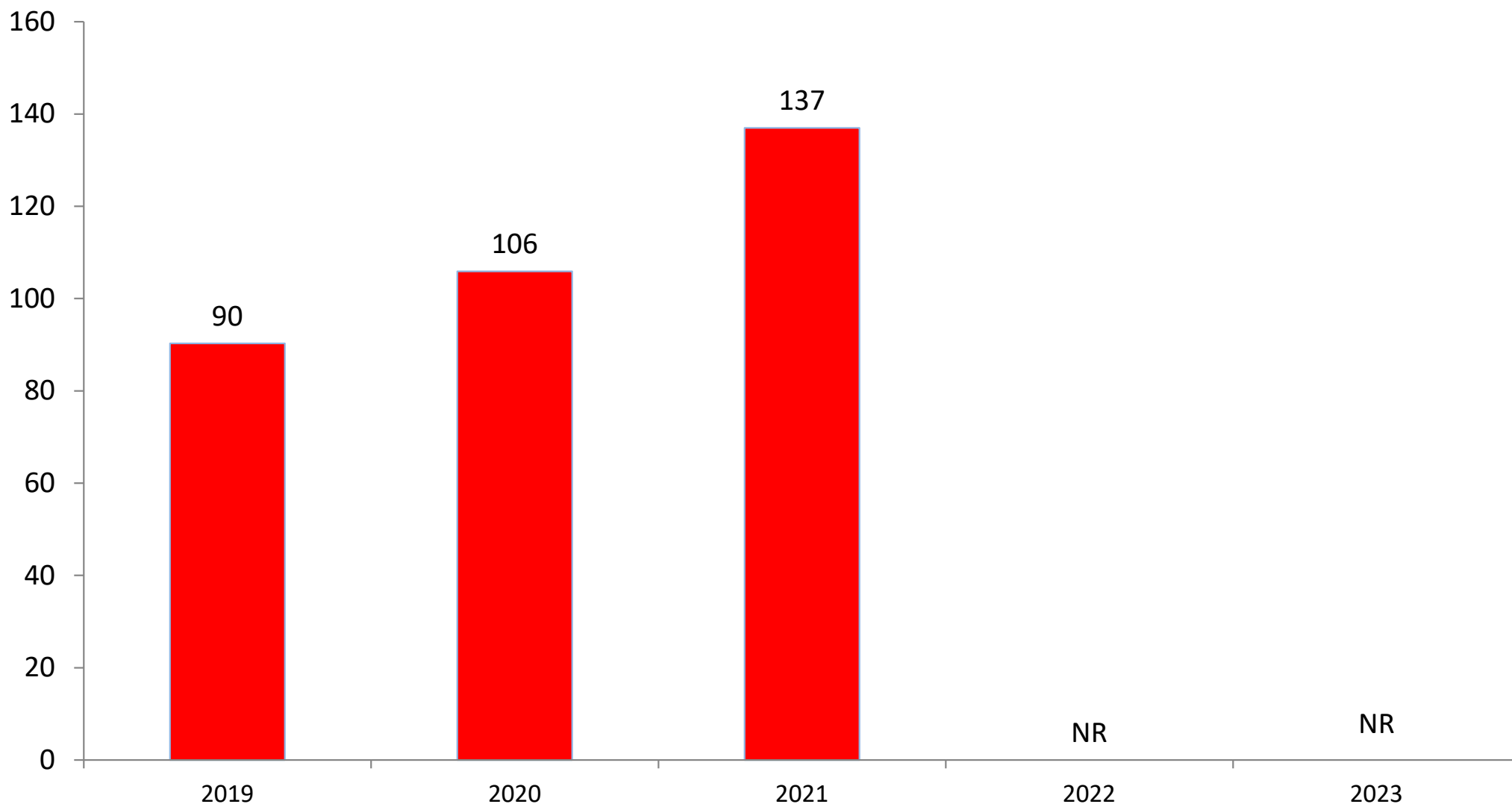

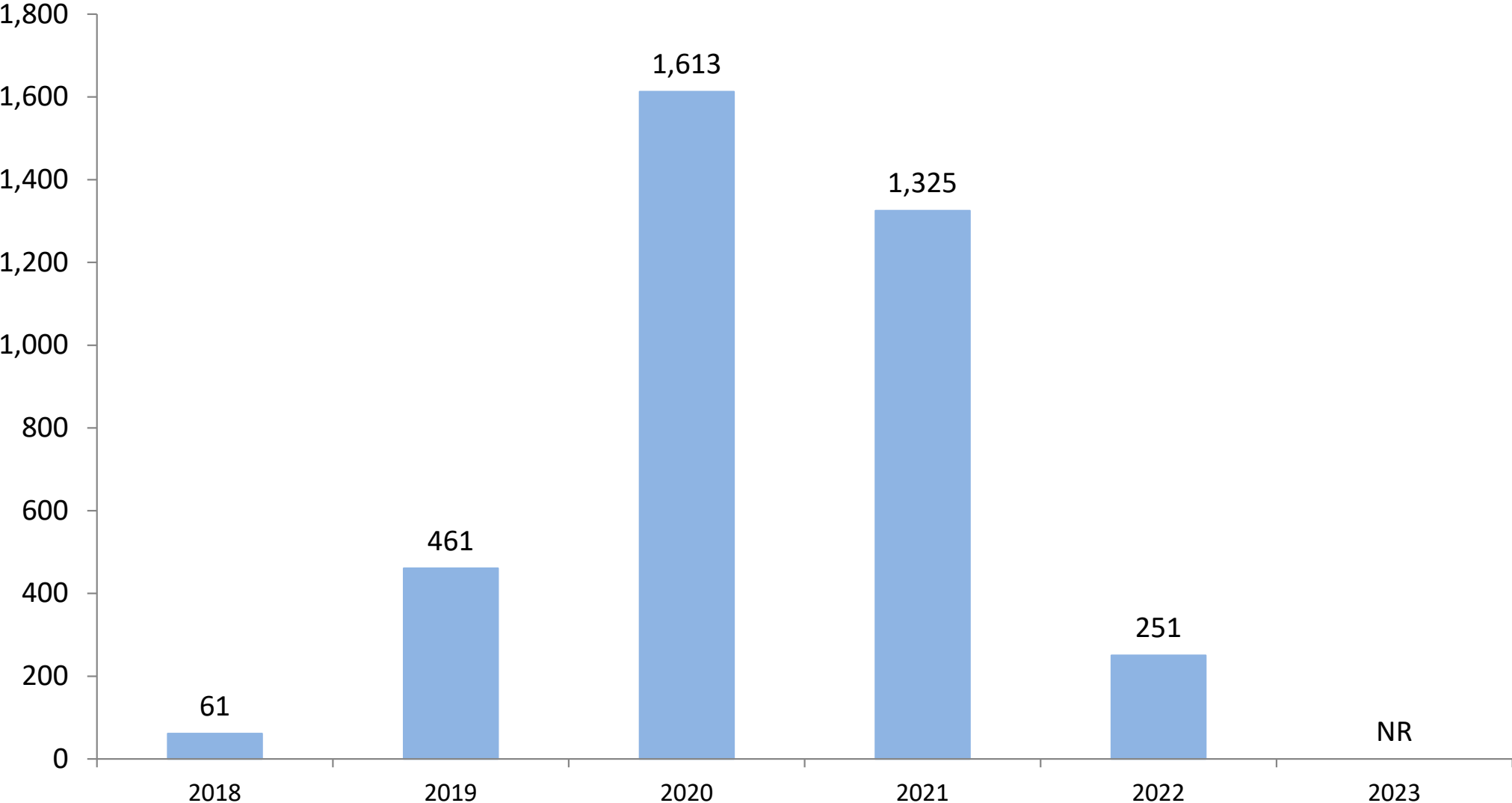

North Carolina Landings, January-March 2018-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

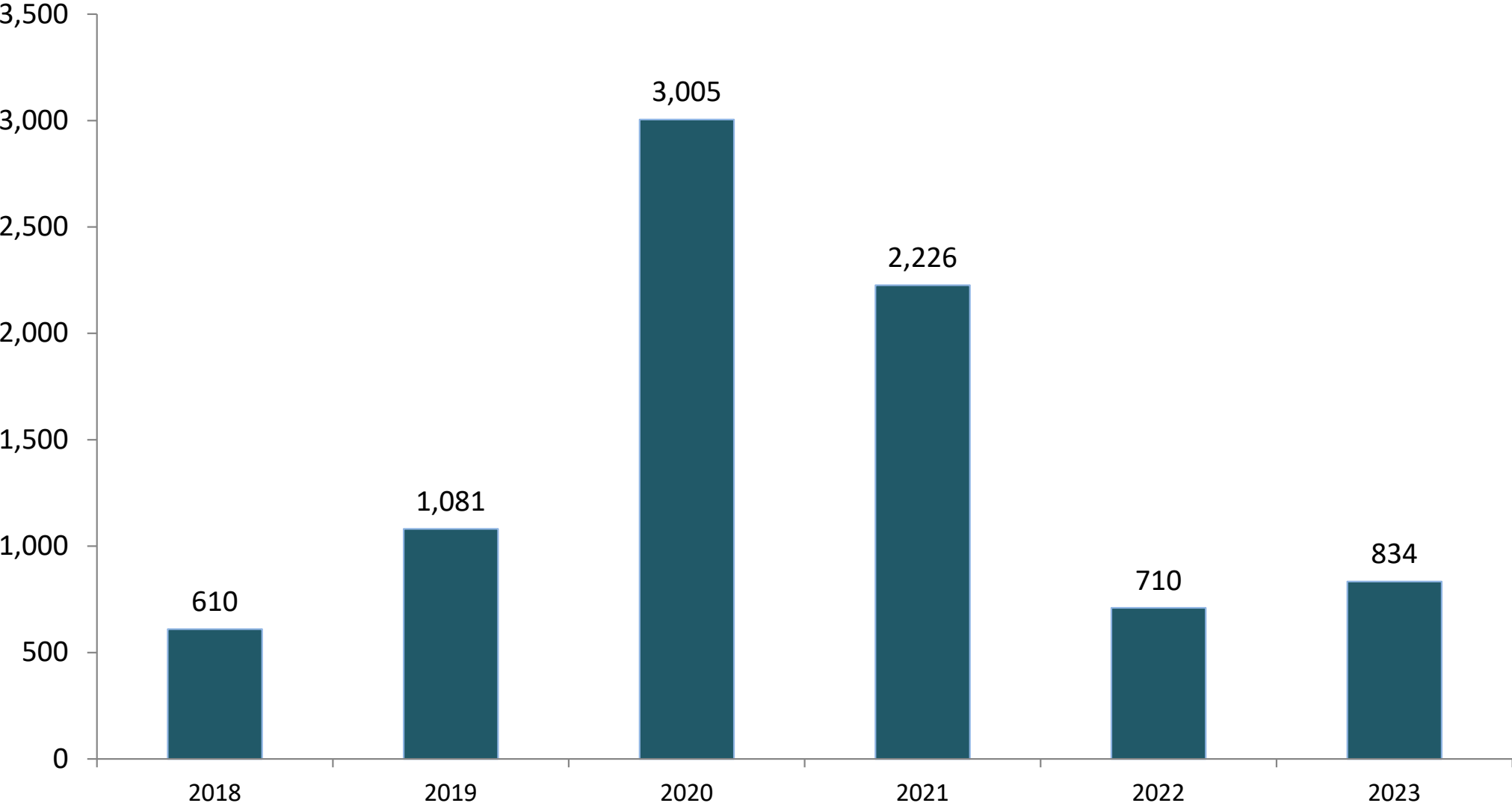

# 2023 Landings in the South Atlantic Are 45.4% Below Historical Averages

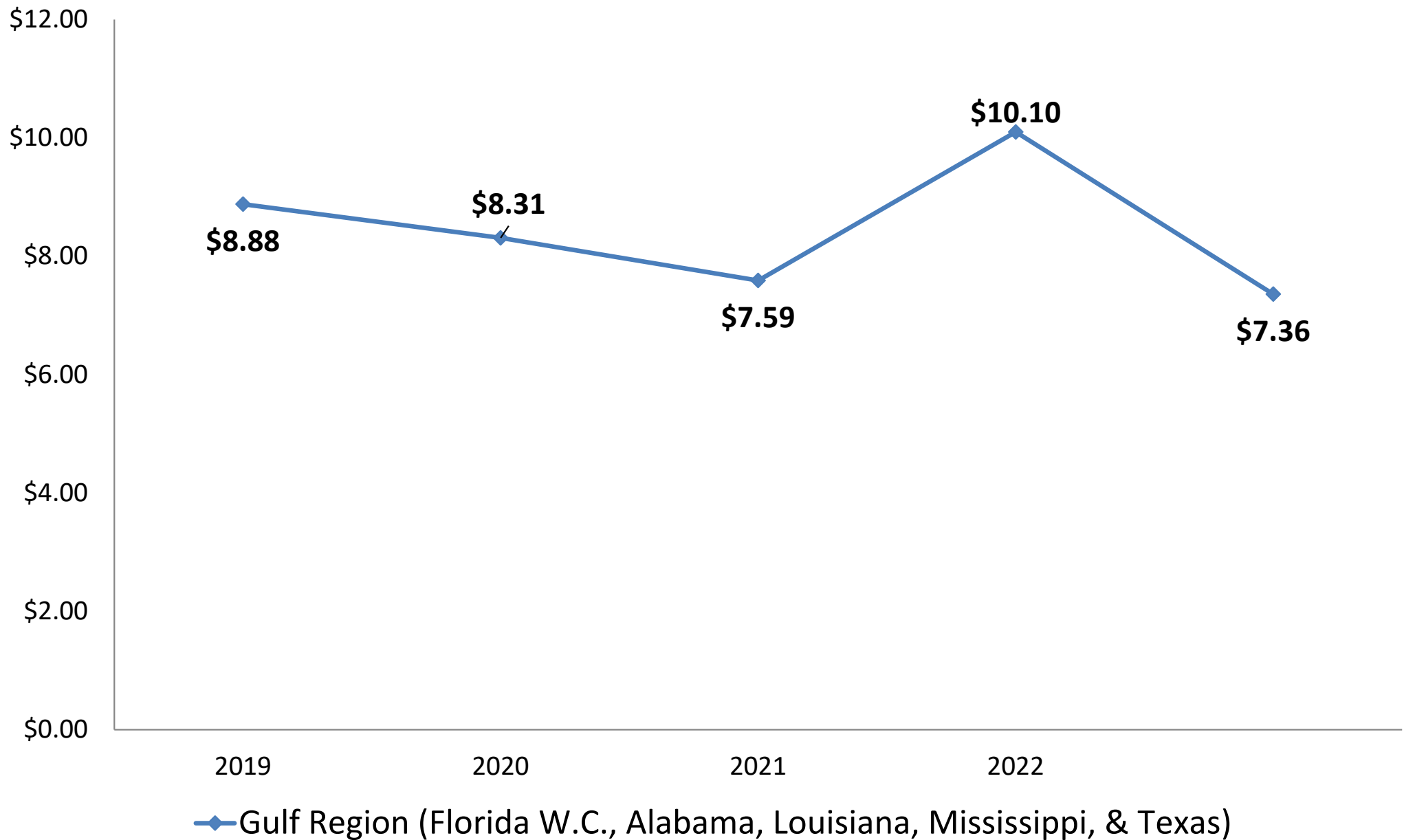


South Atlantic Landings, January-March 2018-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

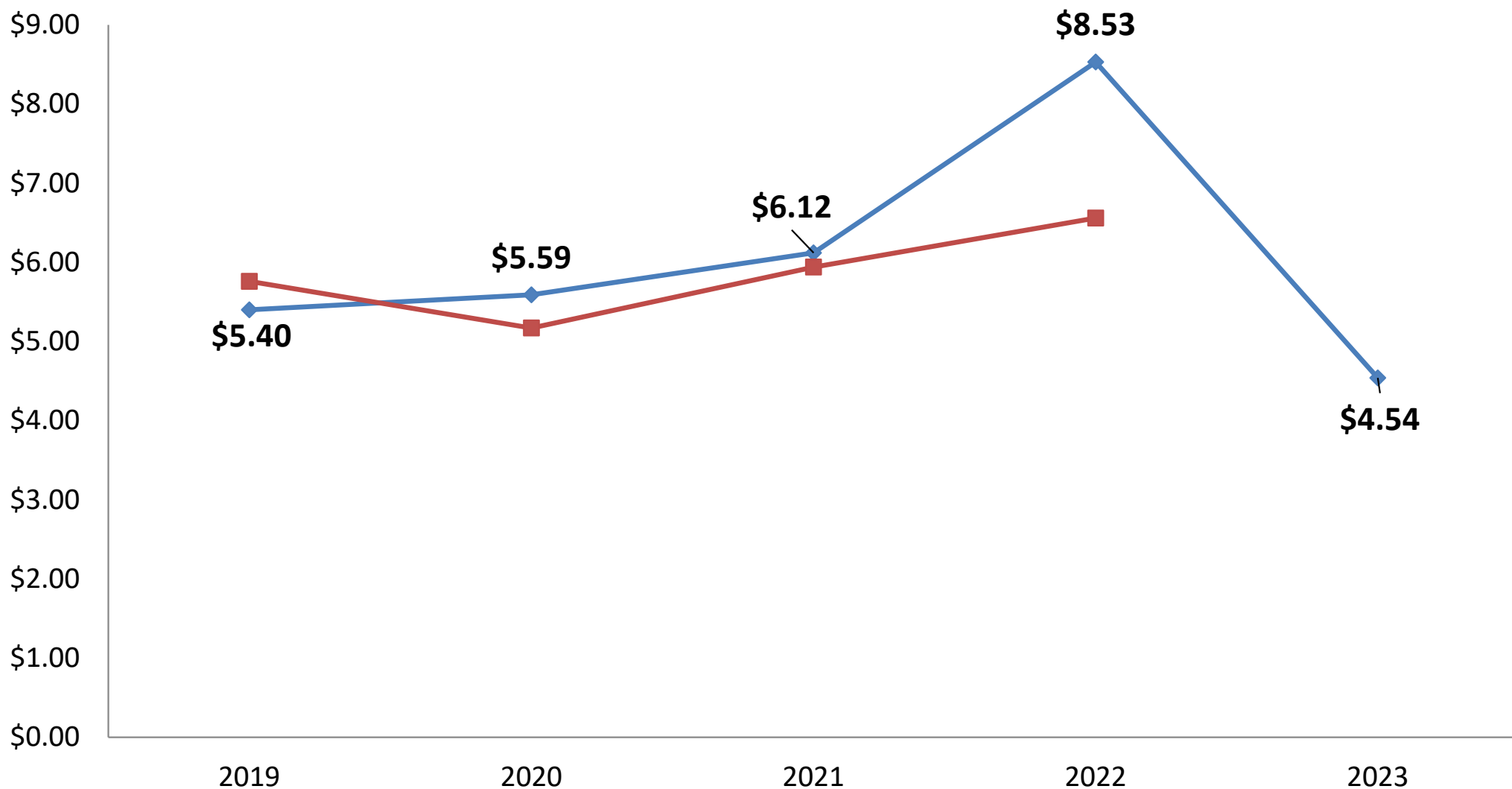

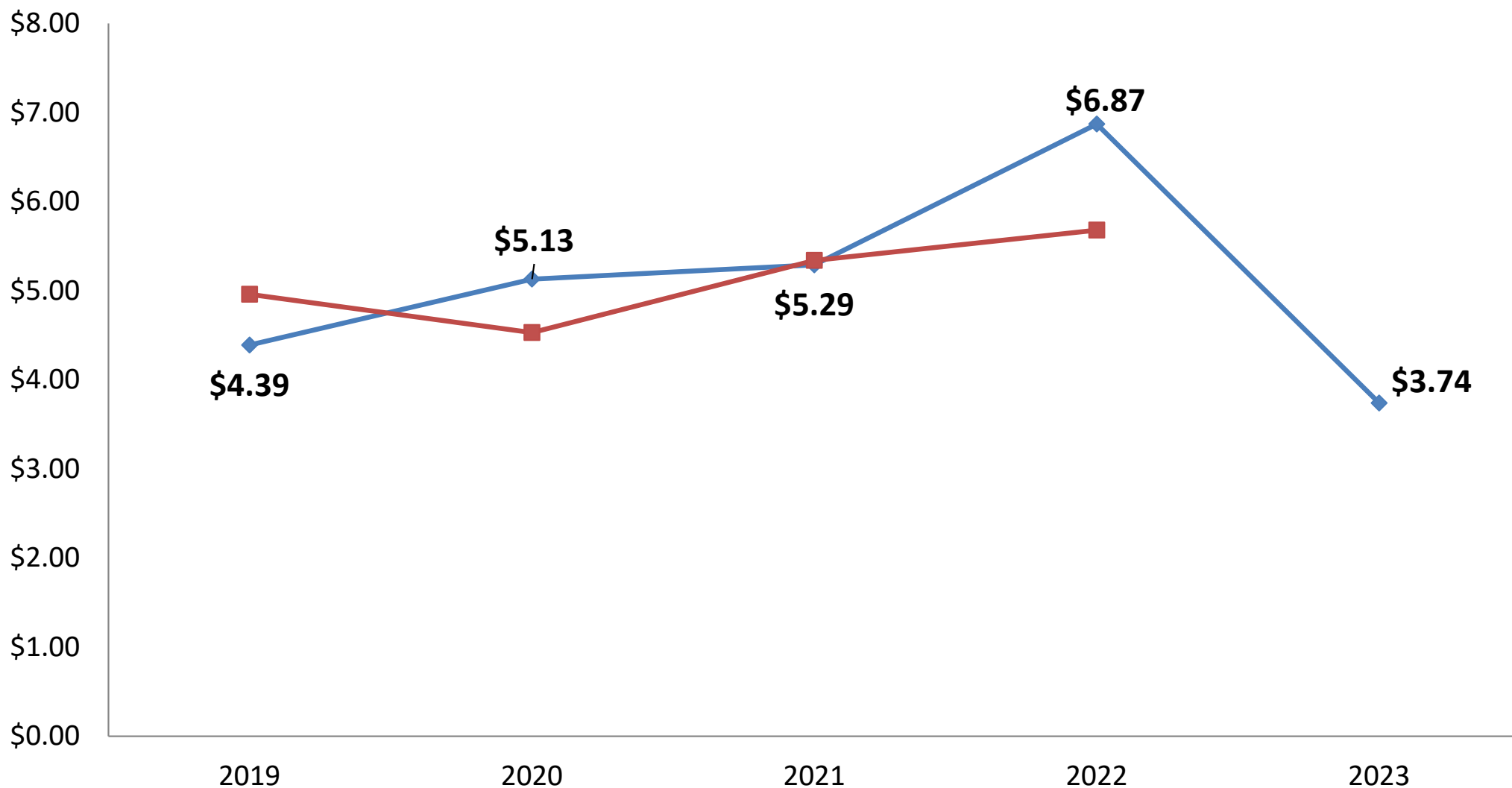

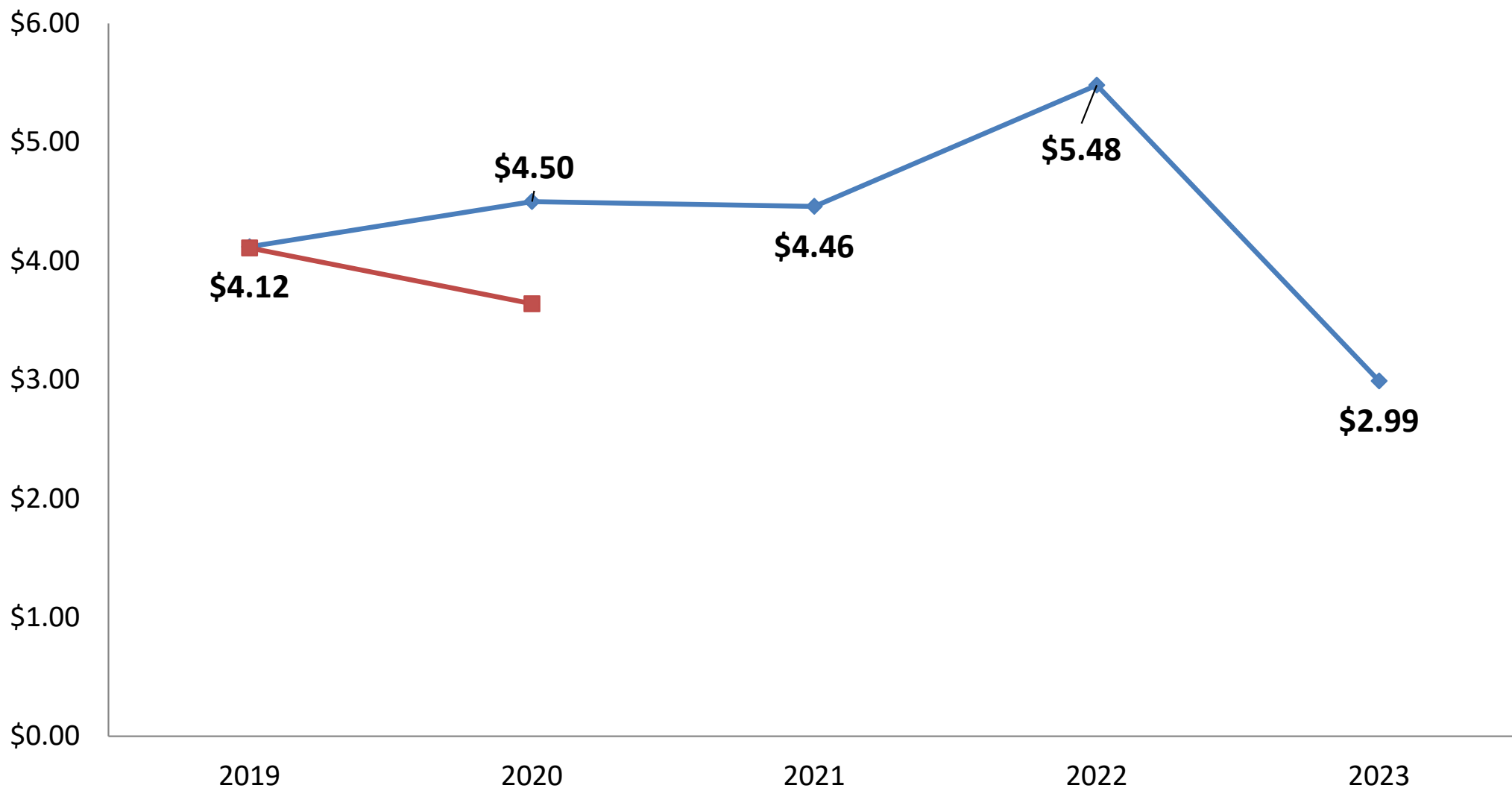

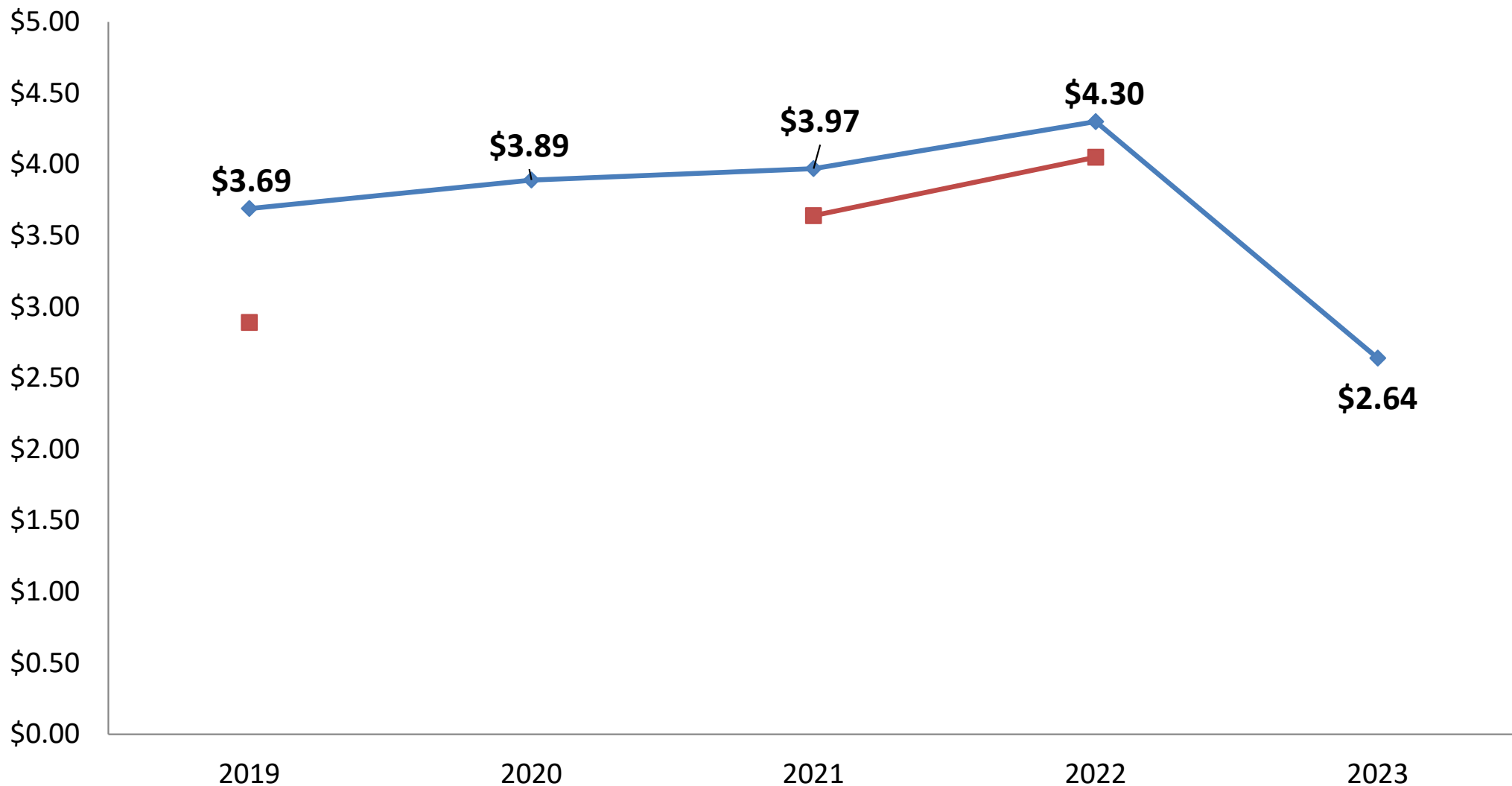

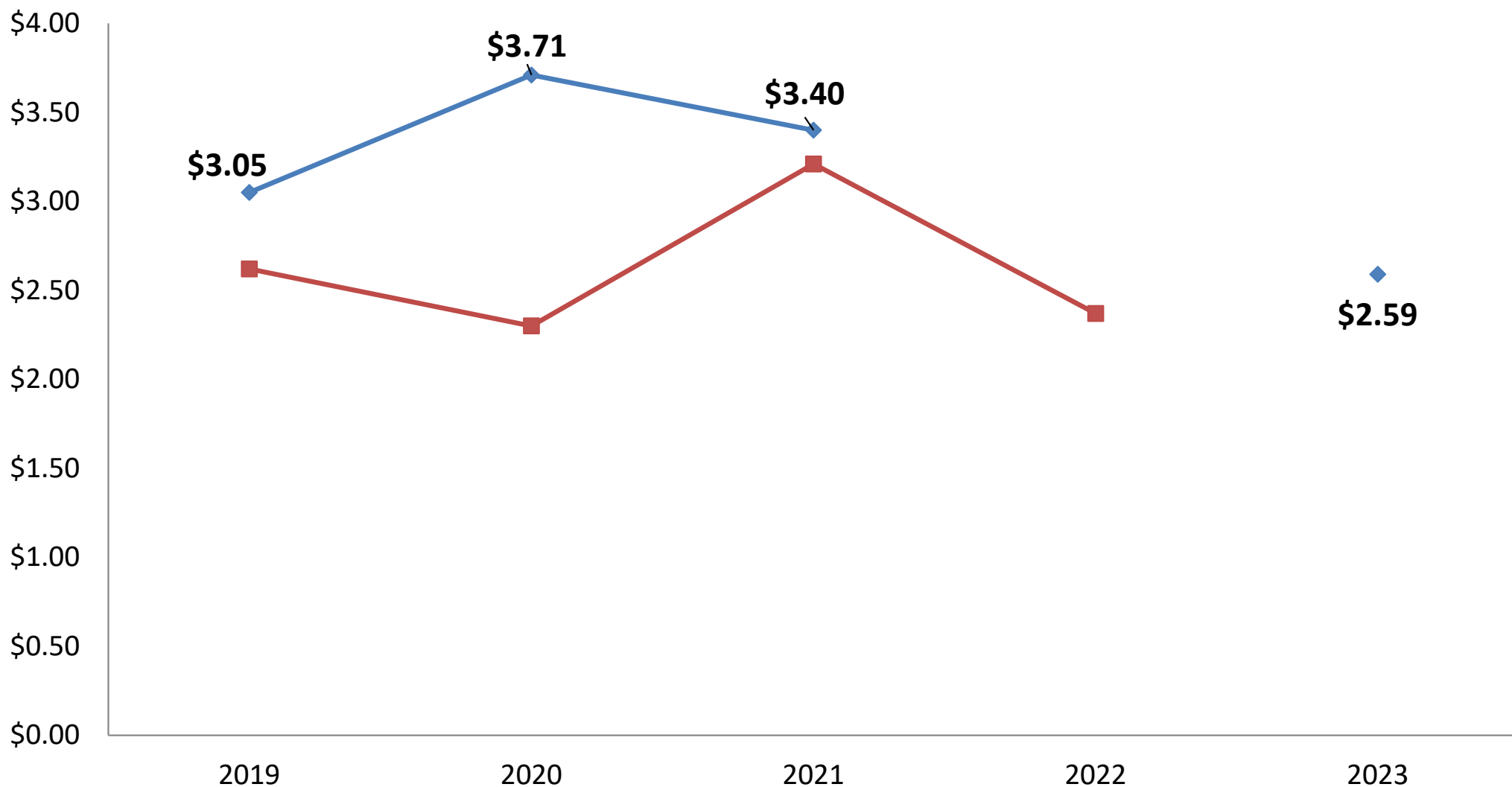

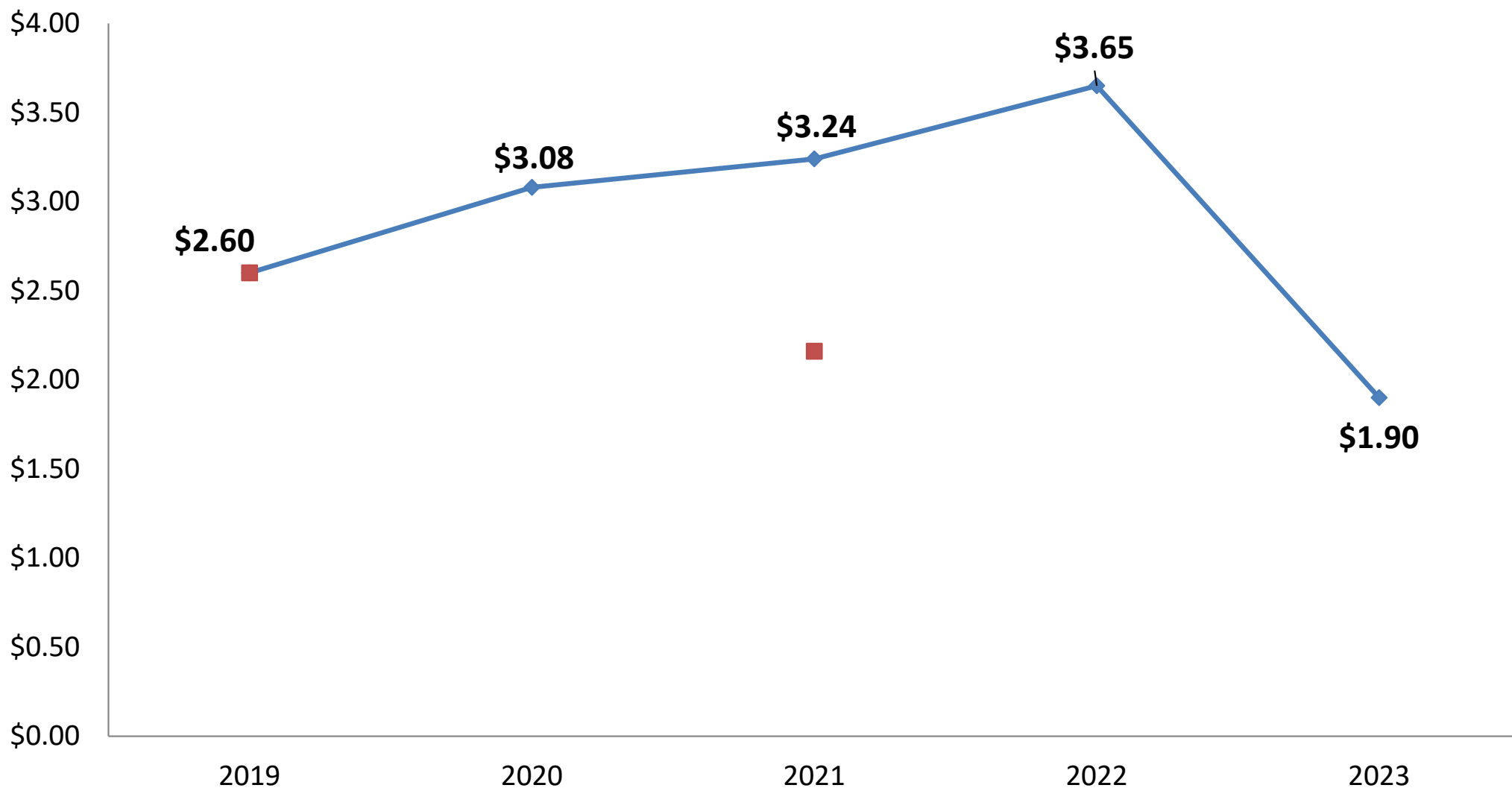
