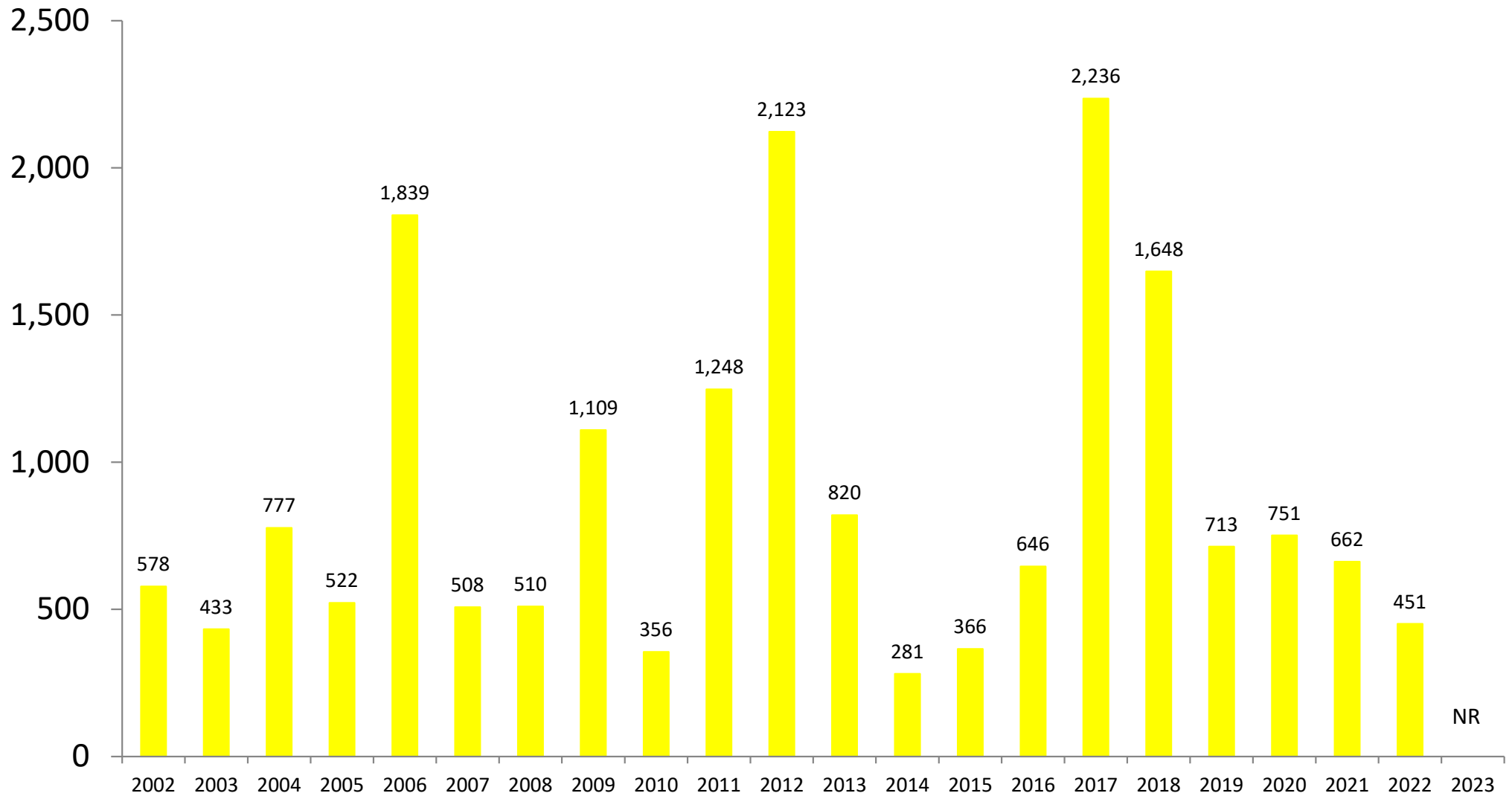

Louisiana Landings, April 2002-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

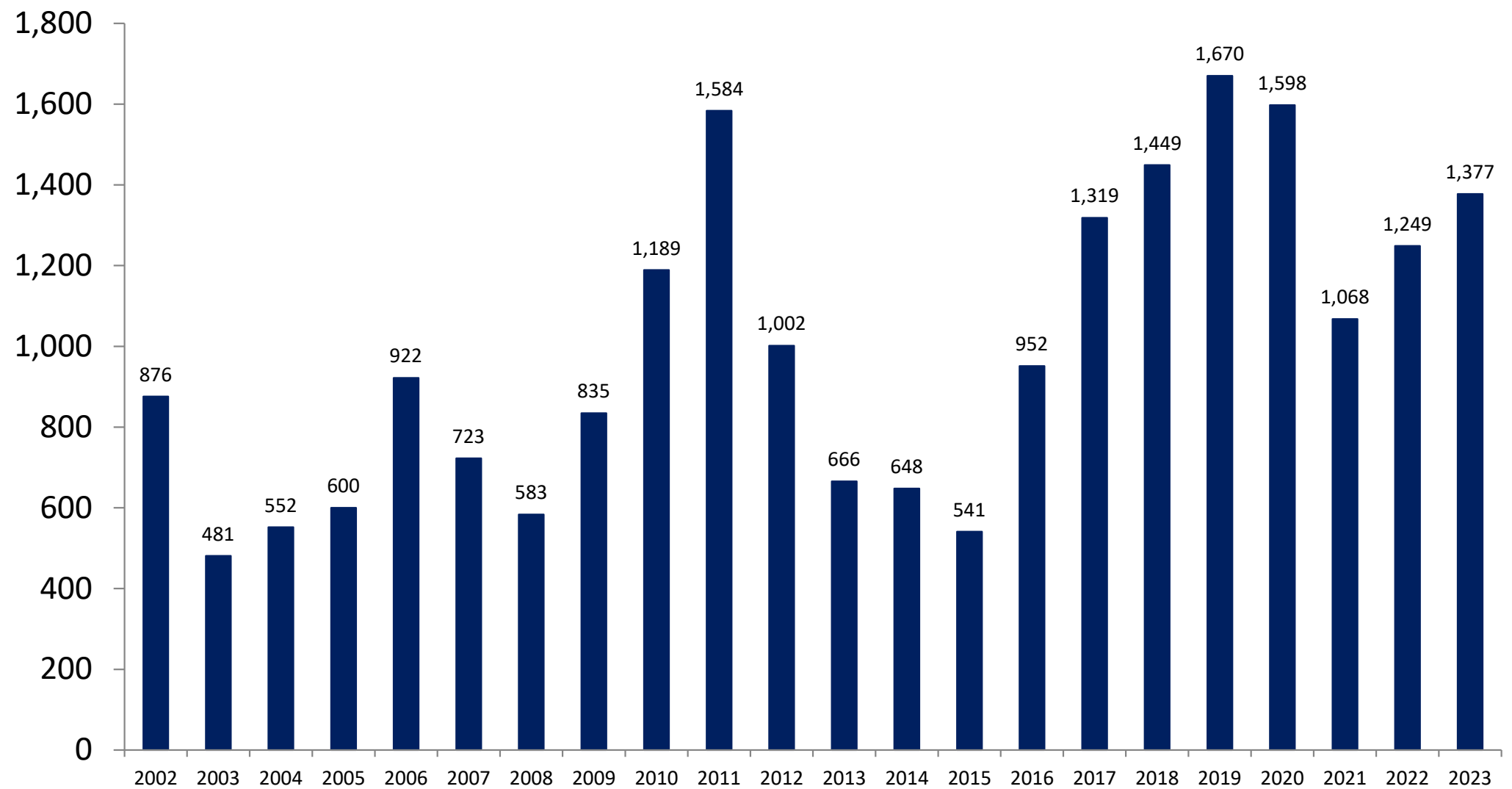

Texas Landings, April 2002-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

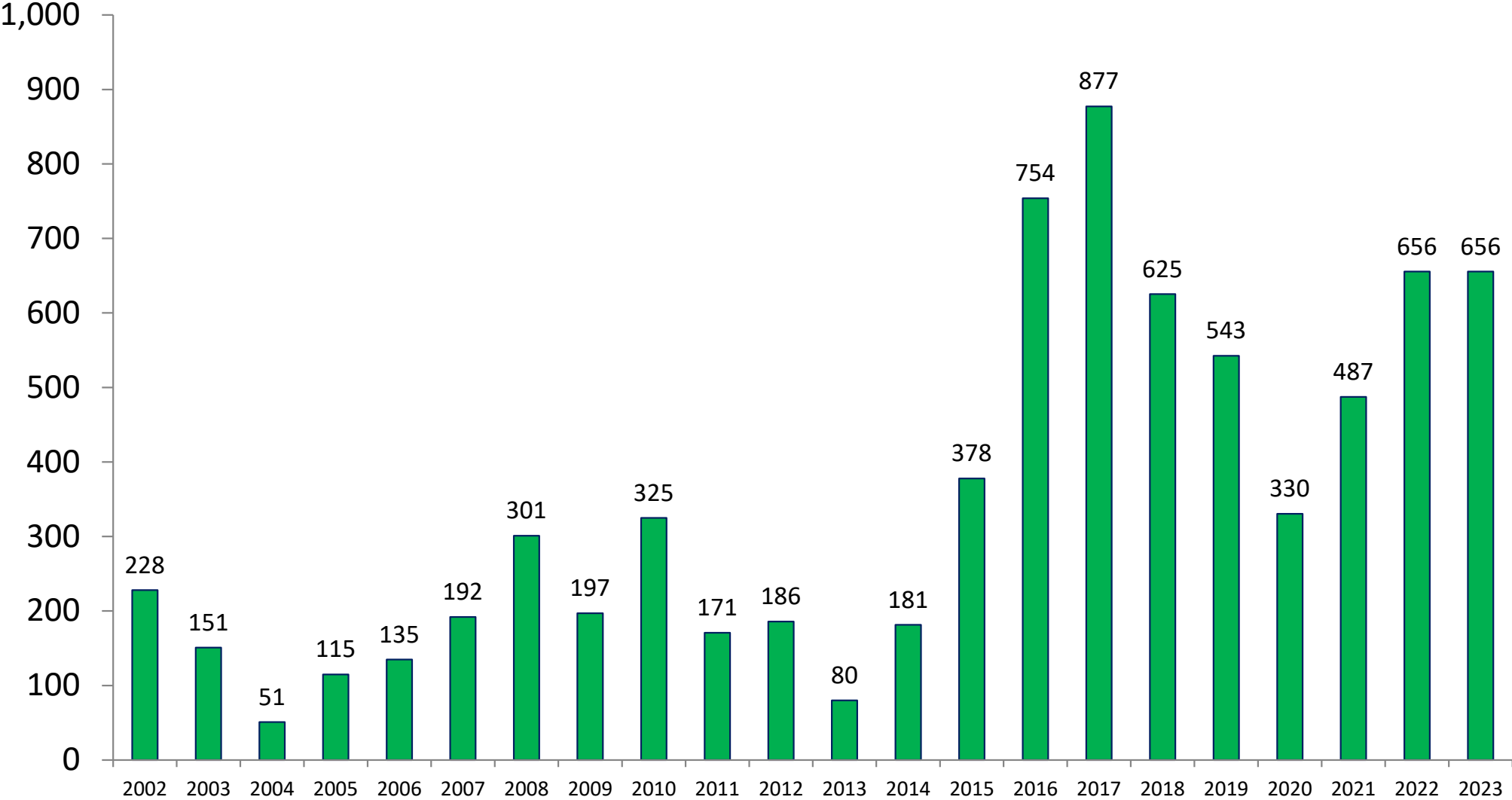


April average for the 2002-2022 period = 976,405 pounds

Alabama Landings, April 2002-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

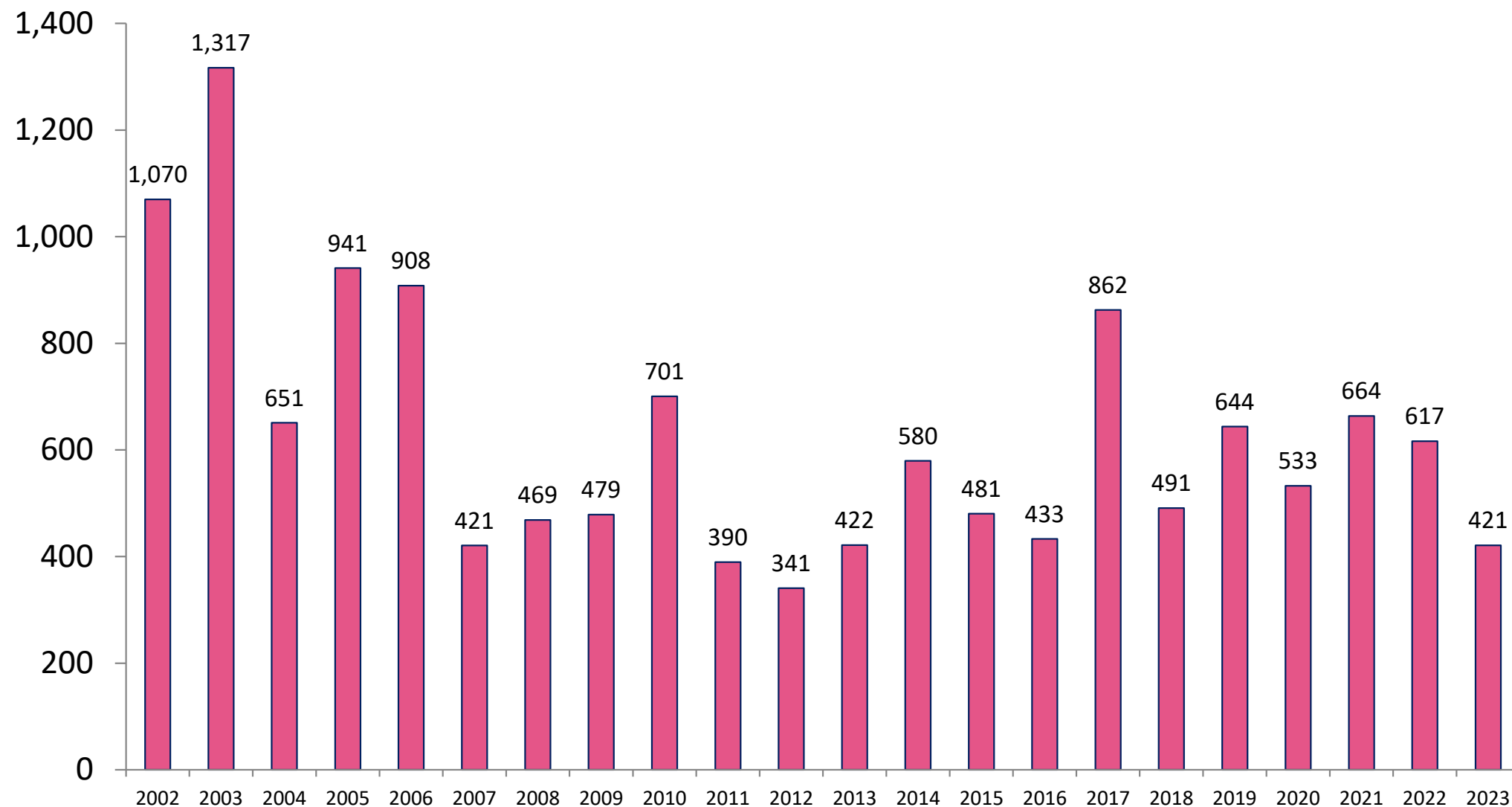

West Coast of Florida Landings, April 2002-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

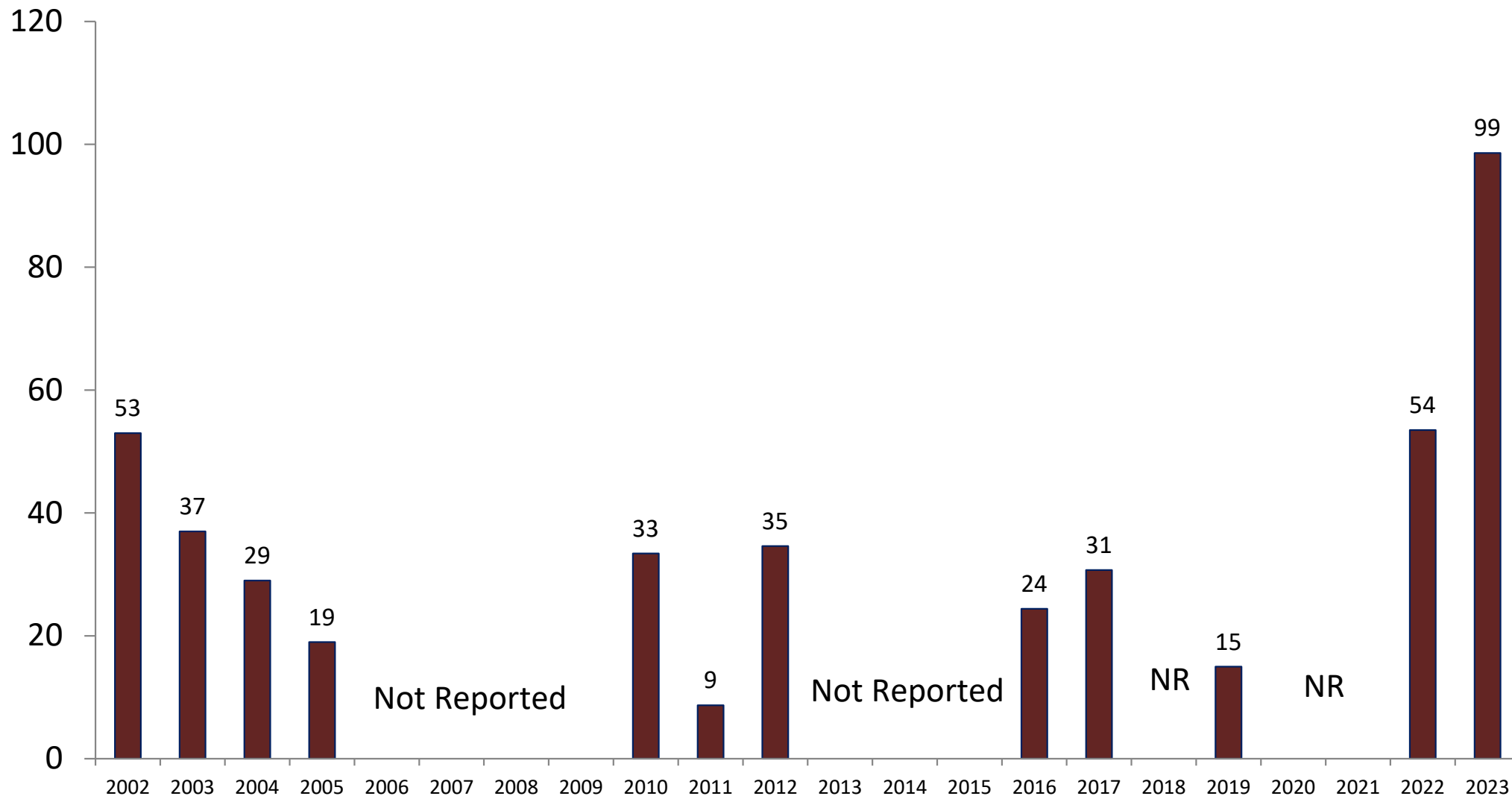

Mississippi Landings, April 2002-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

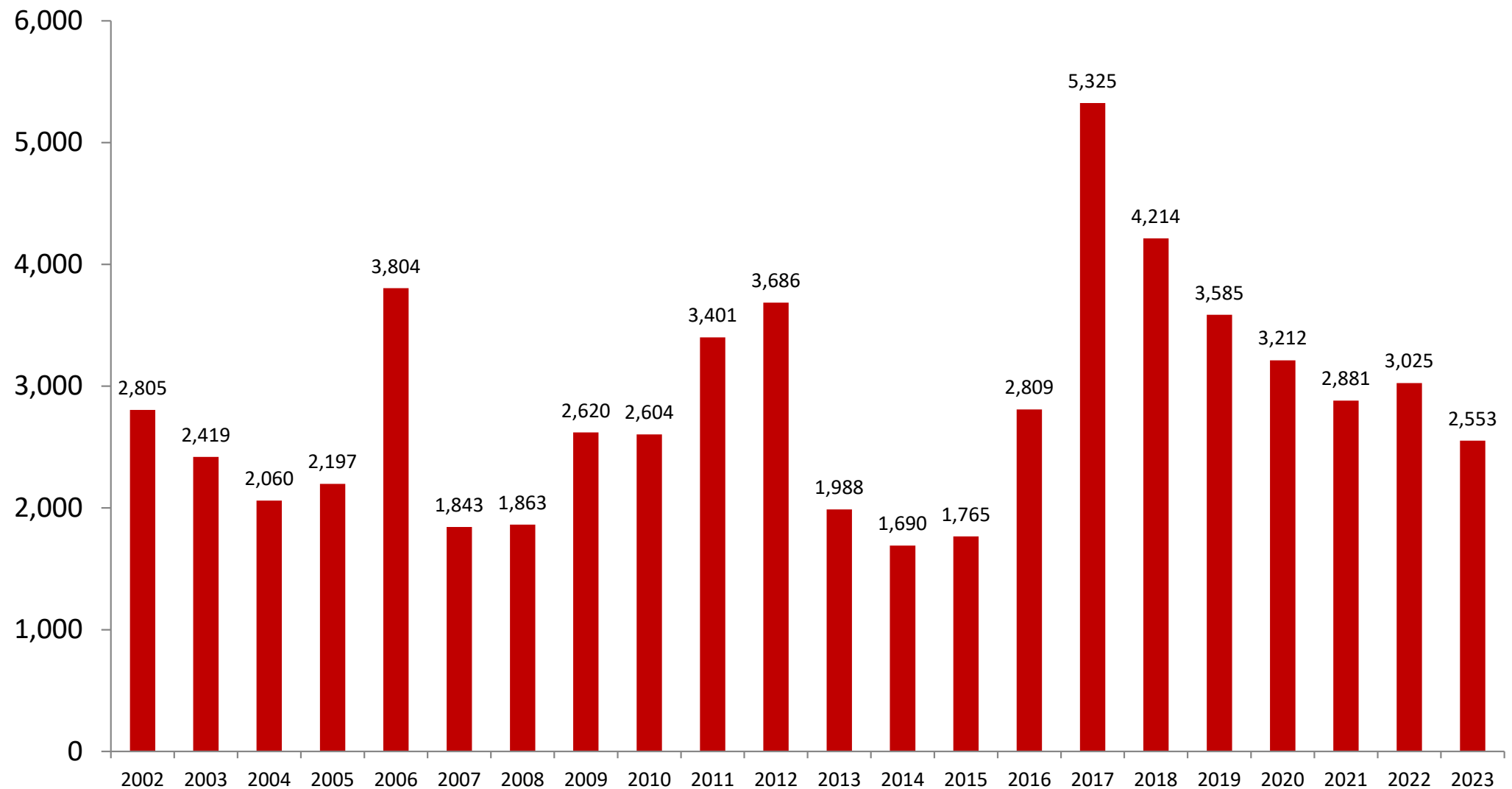

Gulf Landings, April 2002-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

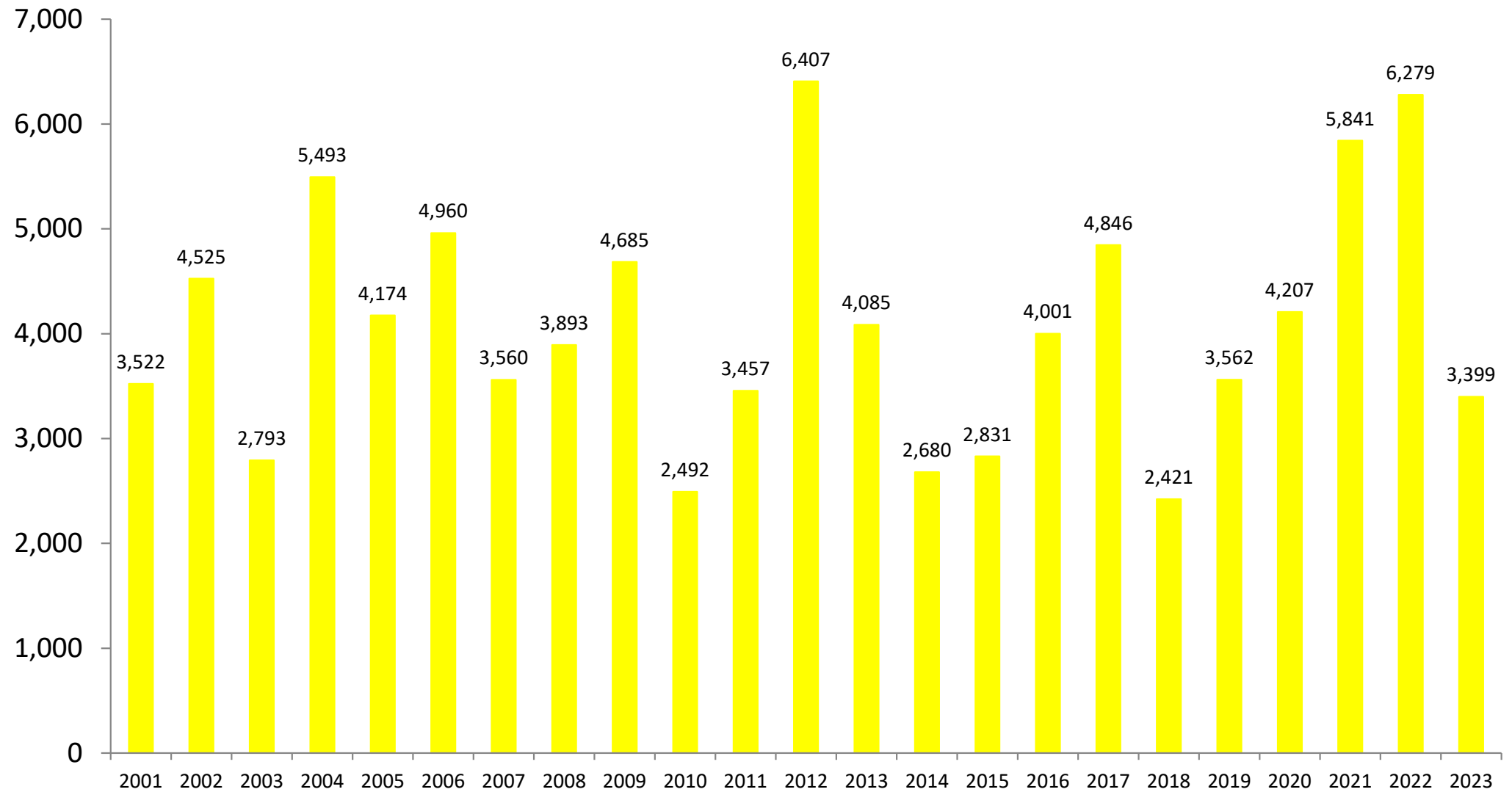

Louisiana Landings, January-April 2001-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

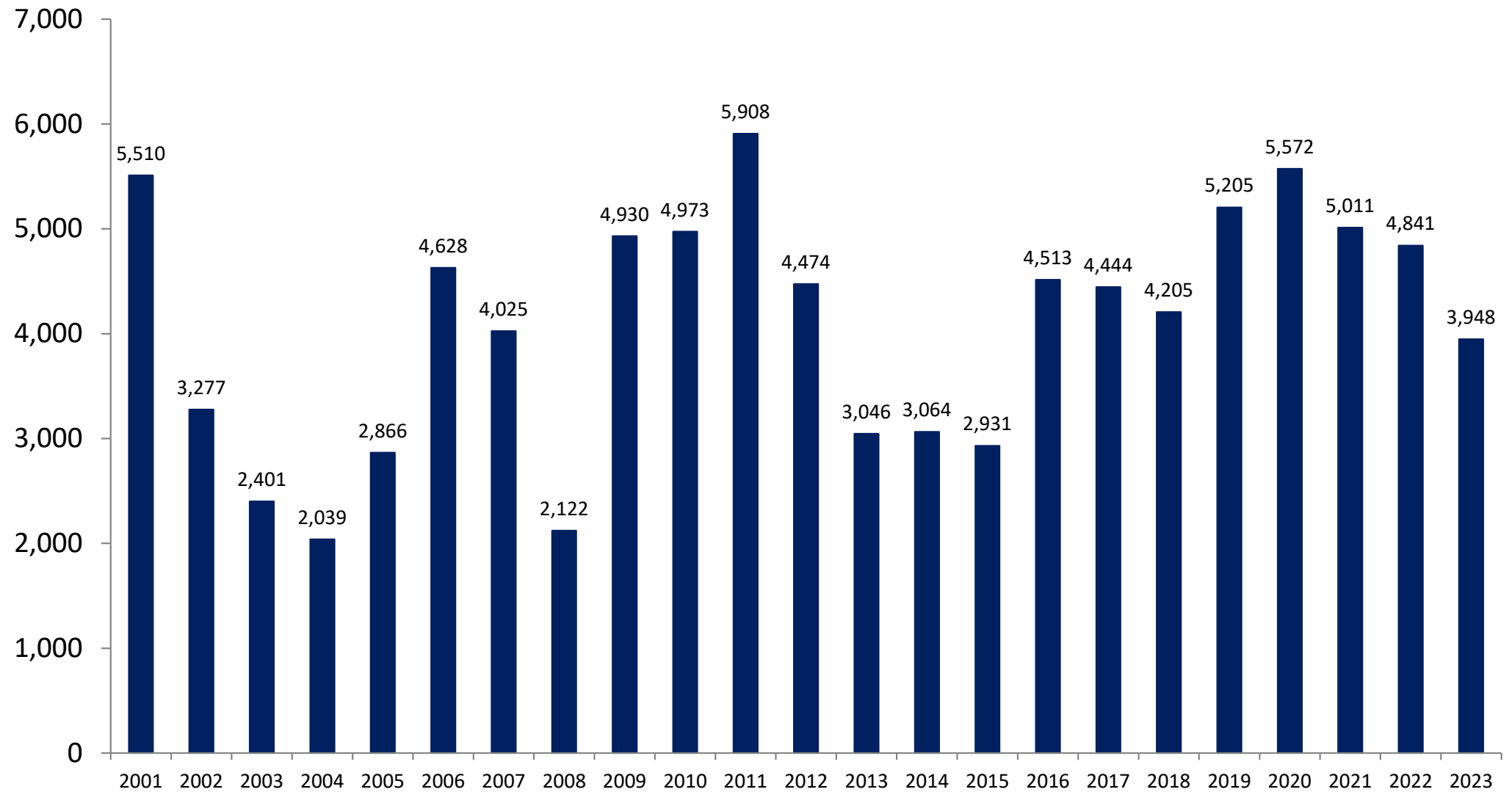


January-April average for the 2001-2022 period = 4,123,346 pounds

Texas Landings, January-April 2001-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

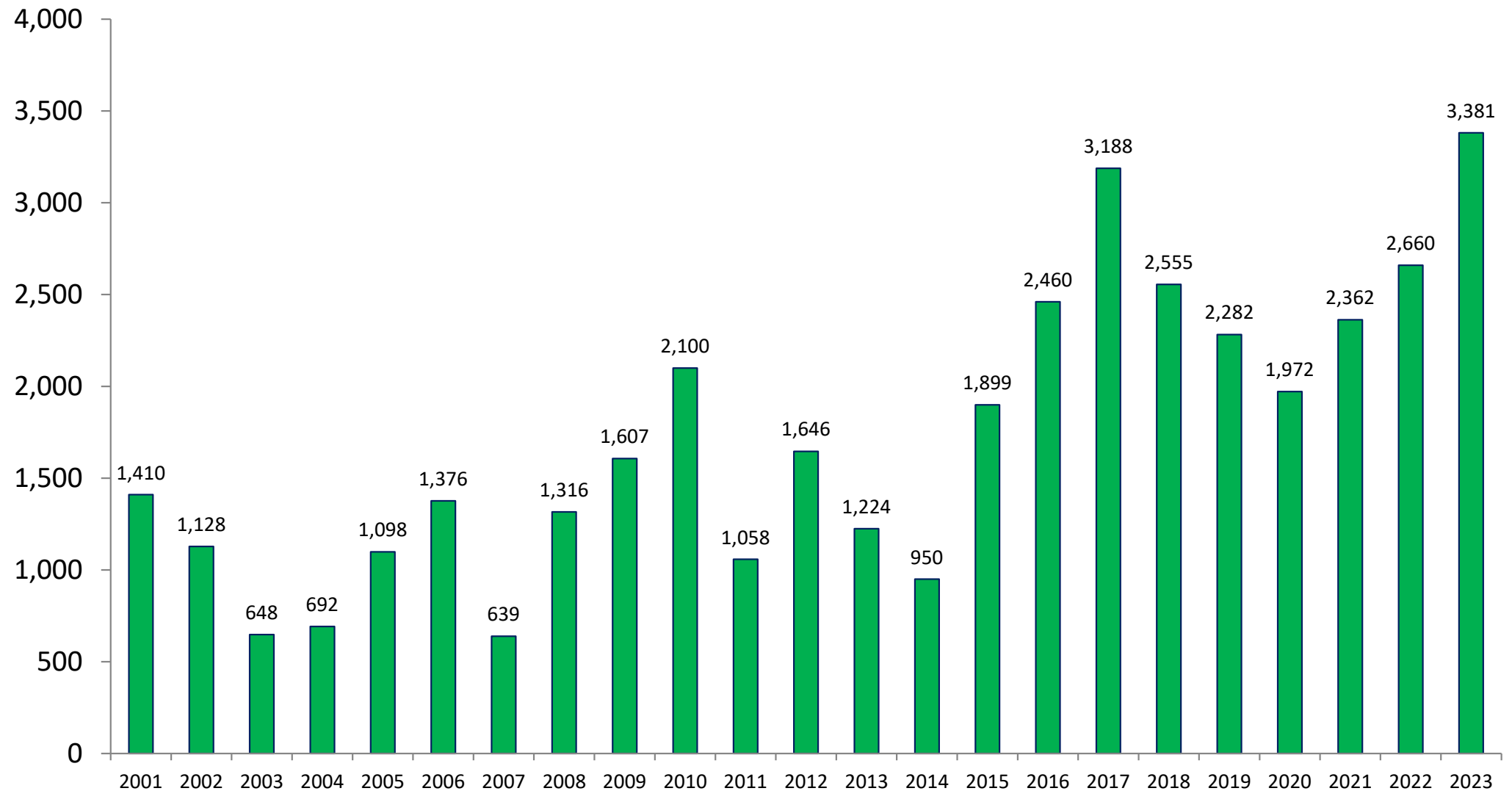


January-April average for the 2001-2022 period = 4,090,296 pounds

Alabama Landings, January-April 2001-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

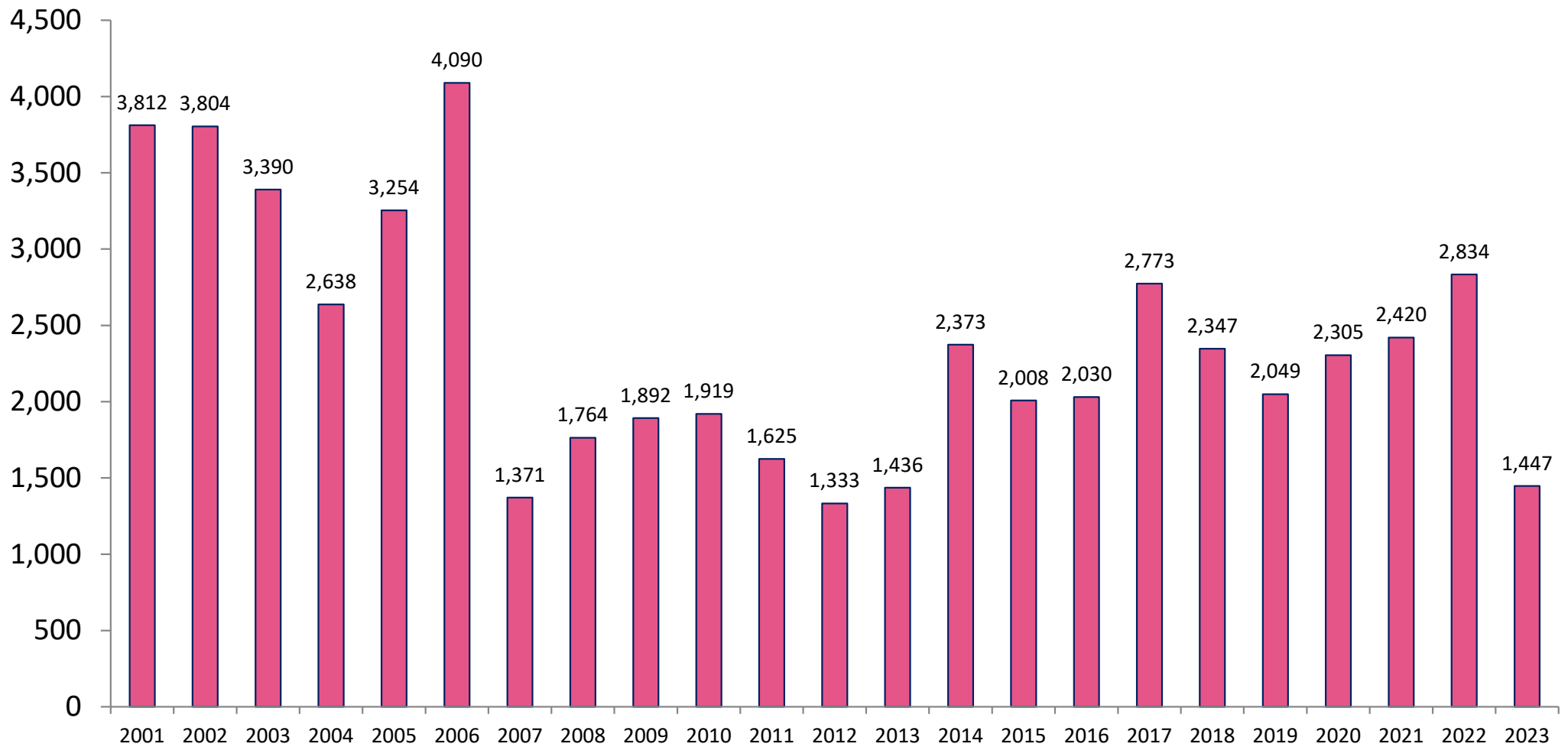


January-April average for the 2001-2022 period = 1,648,609 pounds

West Coast of Florida Landings, January-April 2001-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

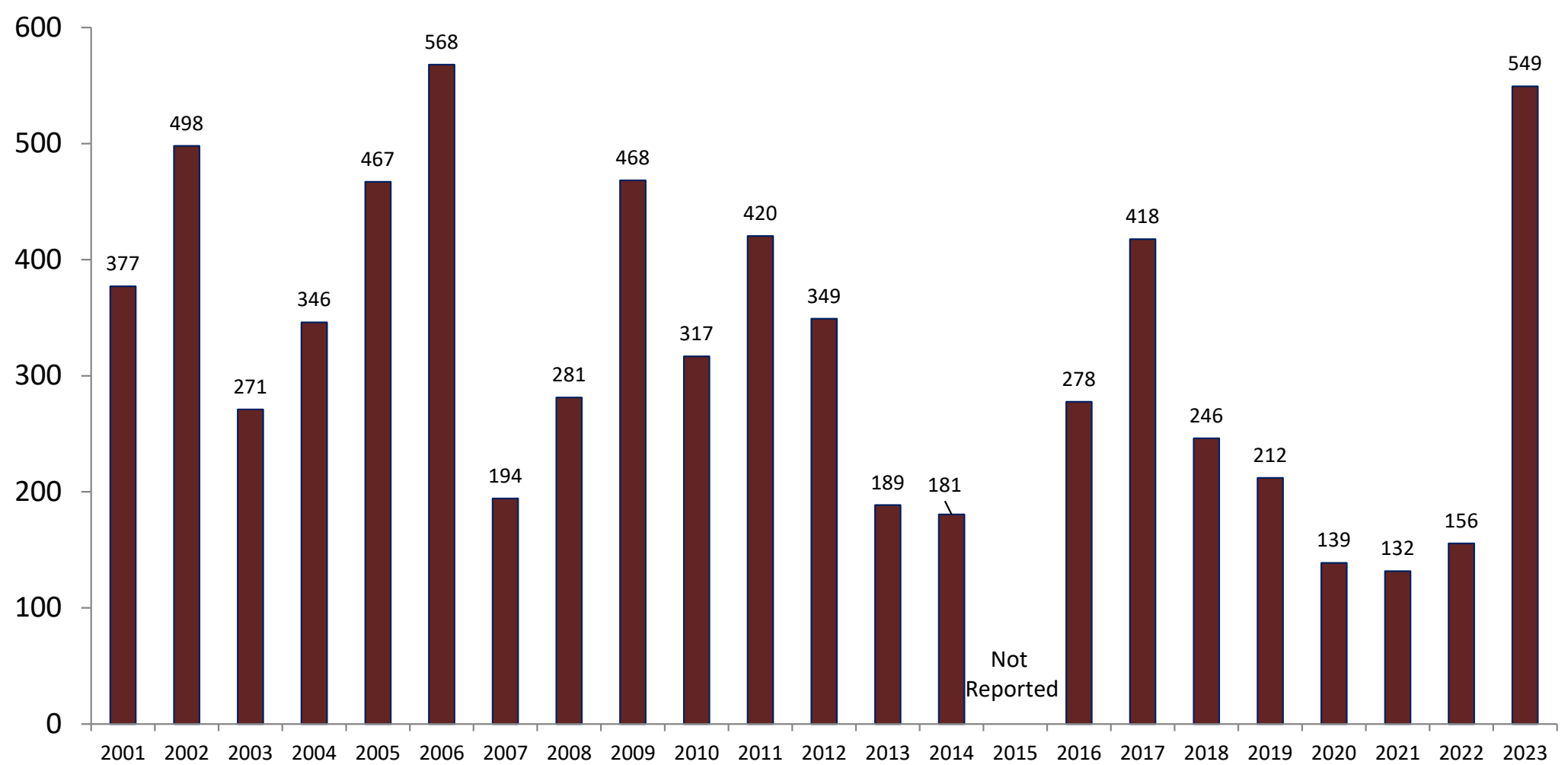


January-April average for the 2001-2022 period = 2,430,336 pounds

Mississippi Landings, January-April 2001-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

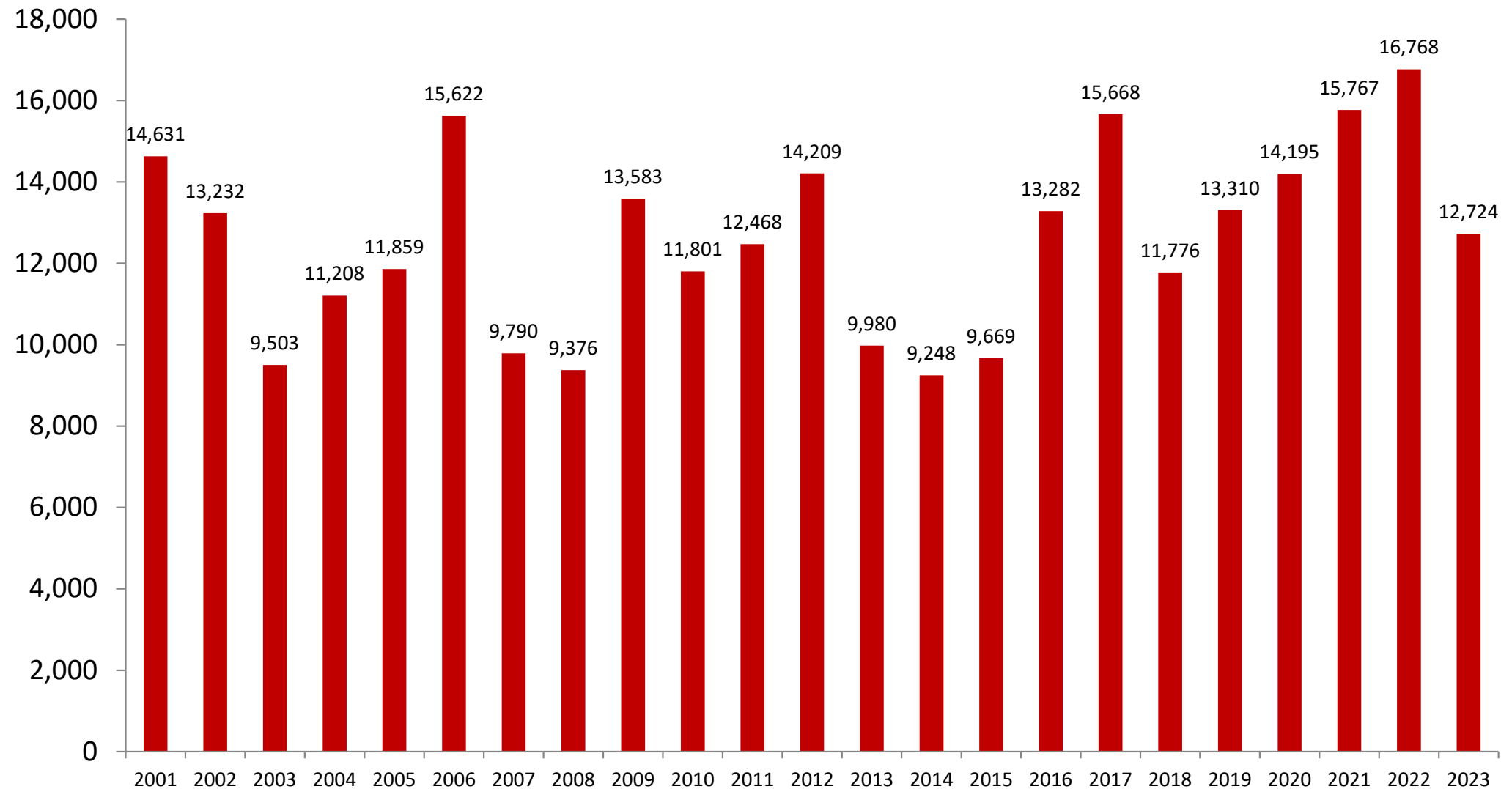


January-April average for the 2001-2022 period = 309,781 pounds

Gulf Landings, January-April 2001-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

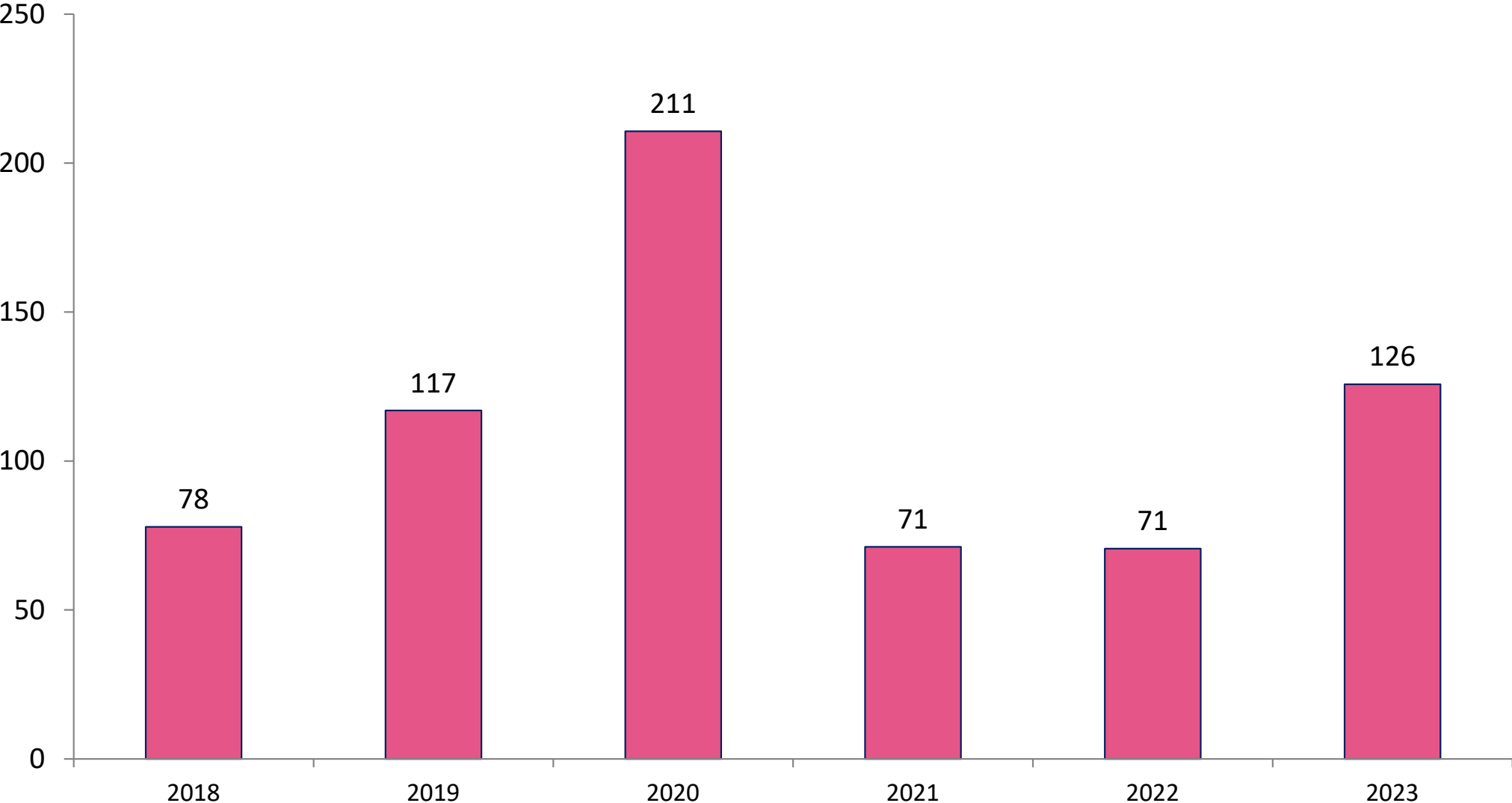

East Coast of Florida Landings, April 2018-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

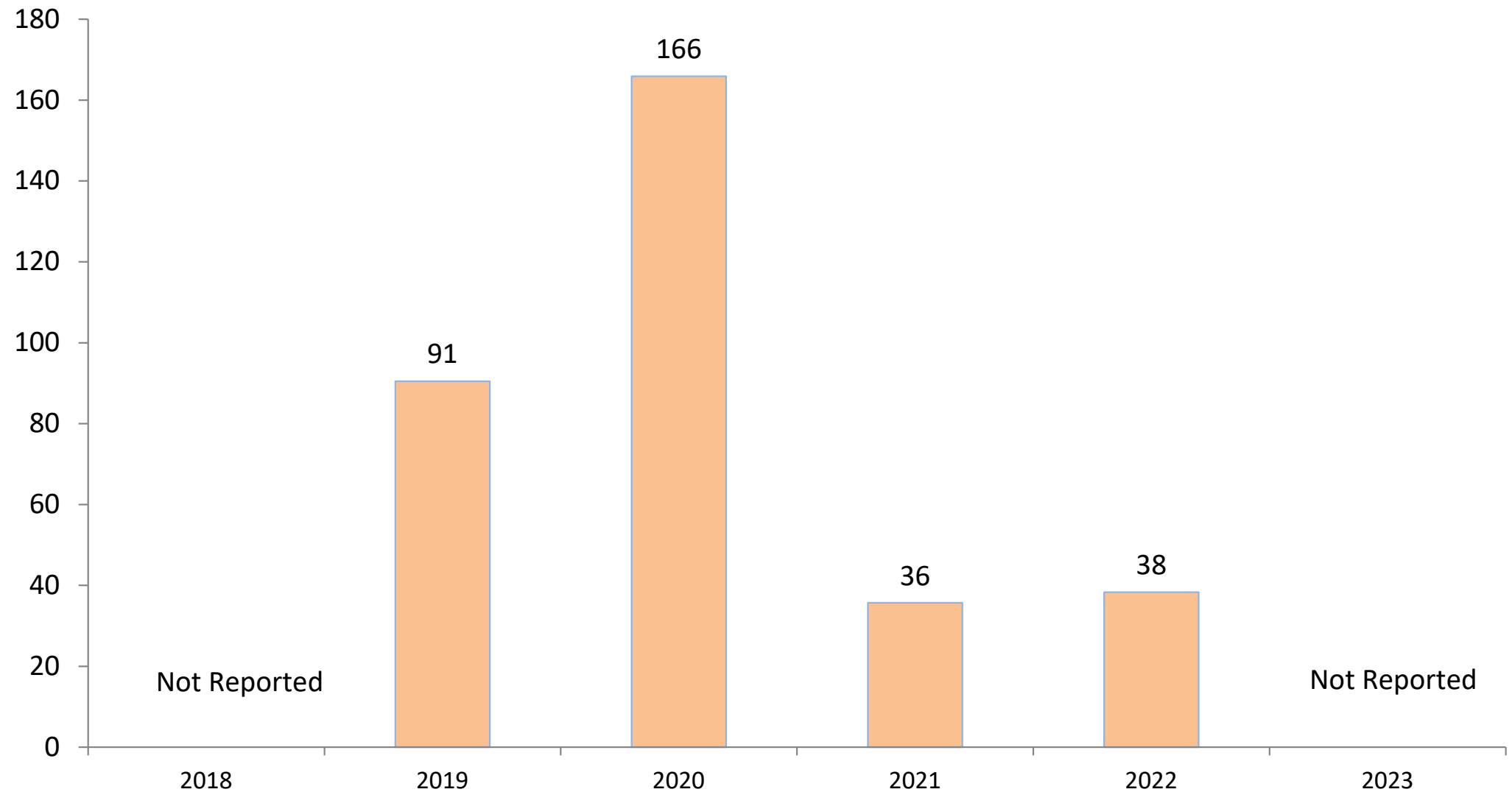

Georgia Landings, April 2018-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

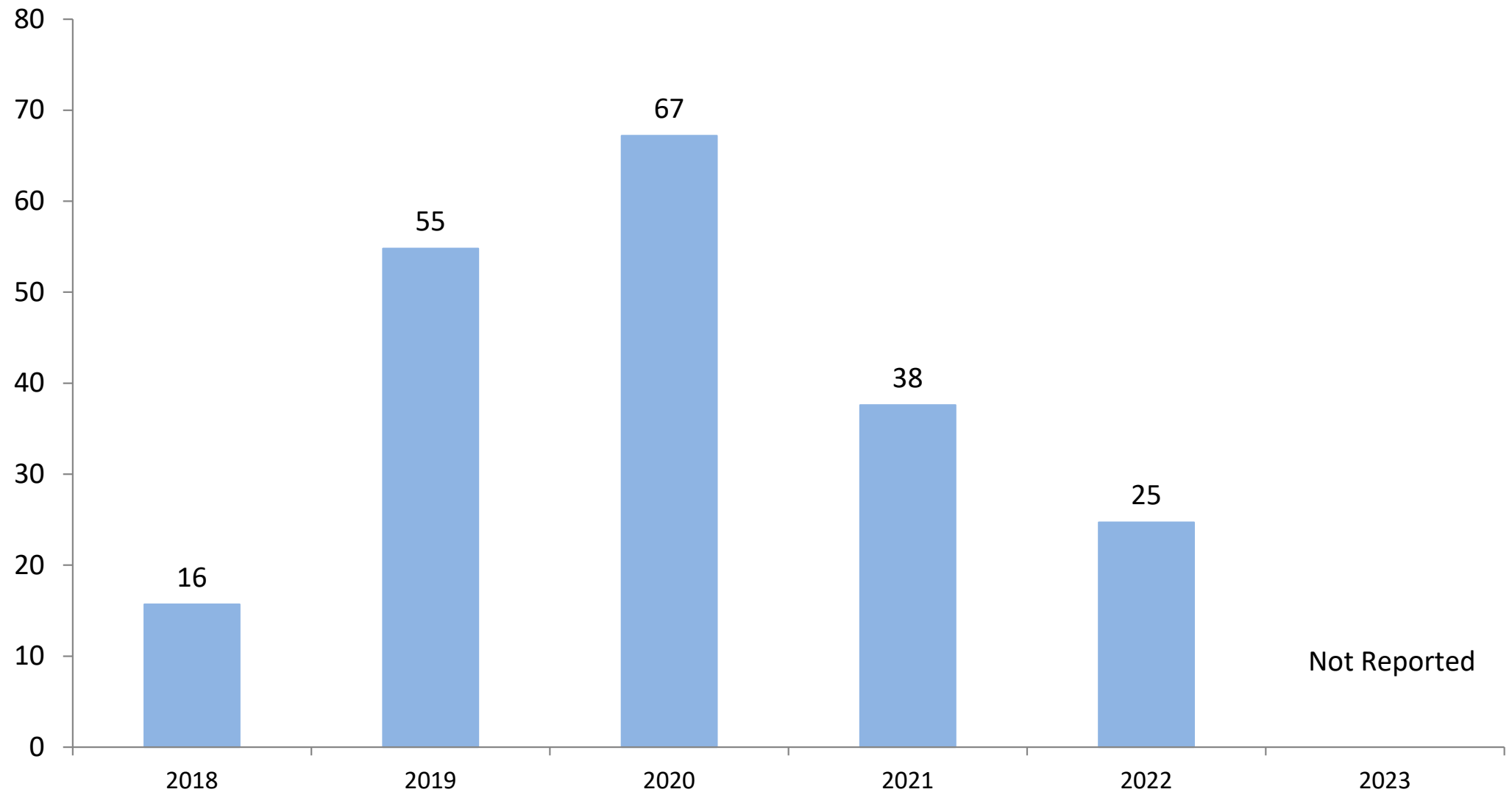

North Carolina Landings, April 2018-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

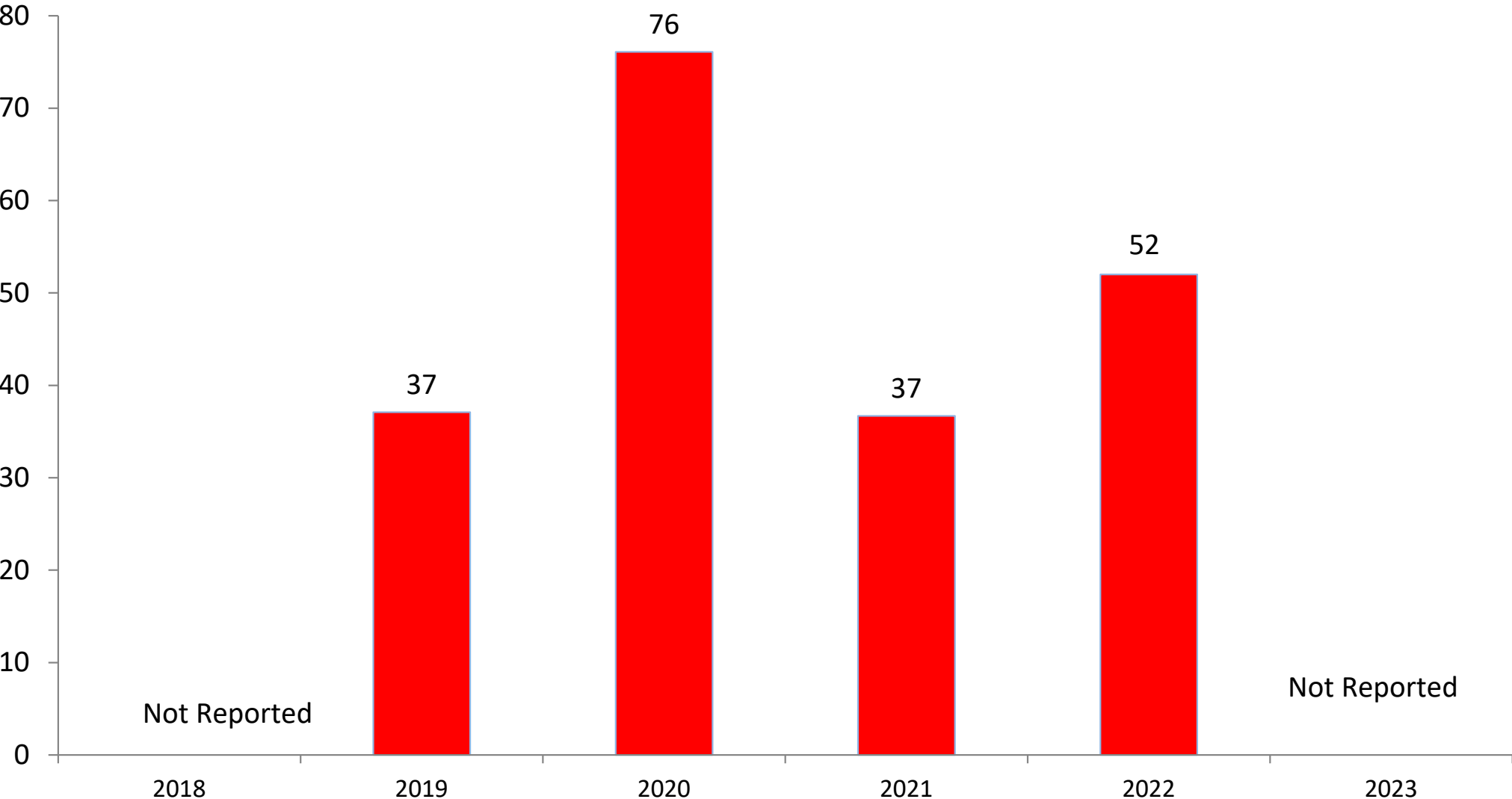

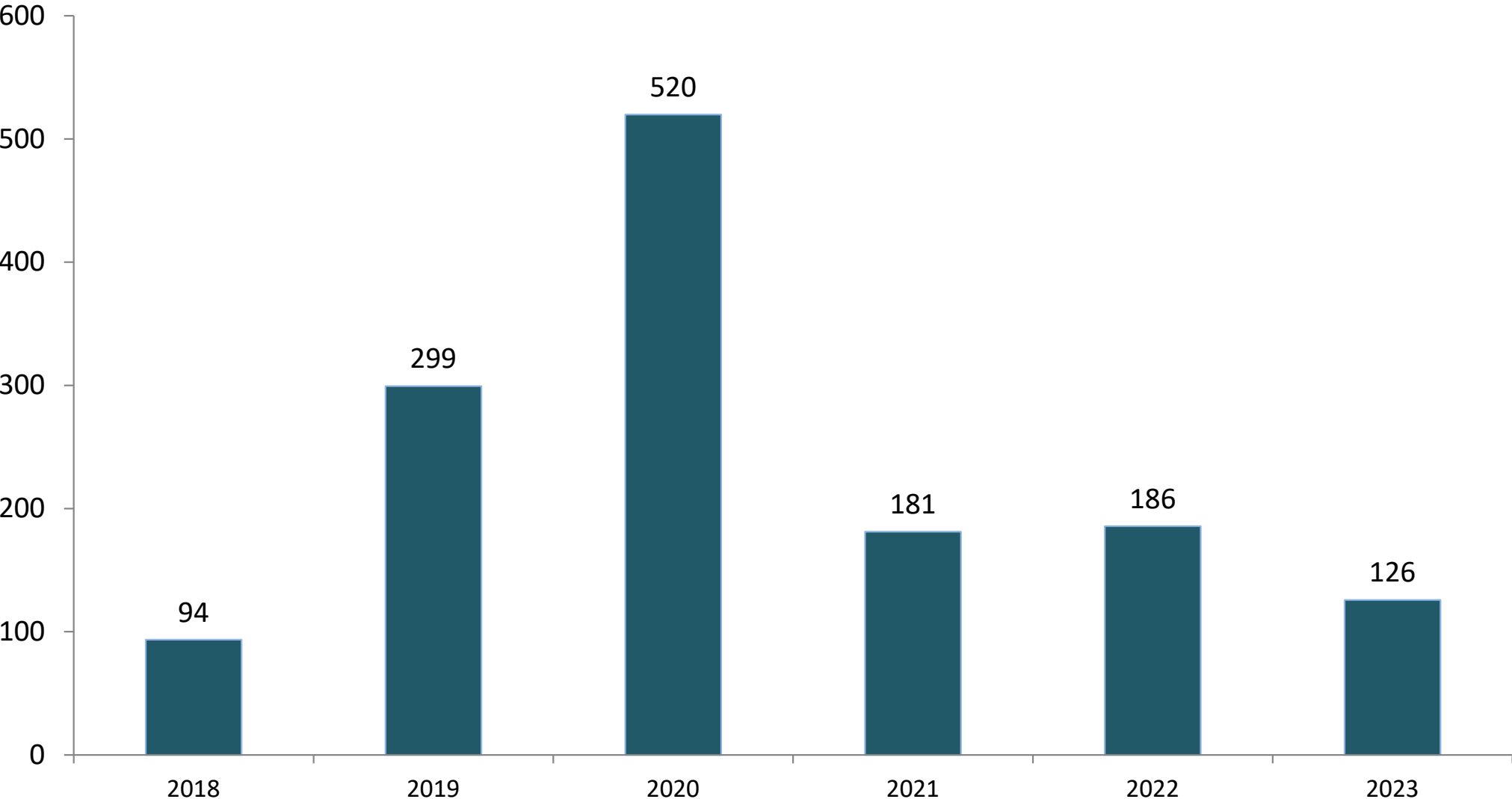

South Atlantic Landings, April 2018-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

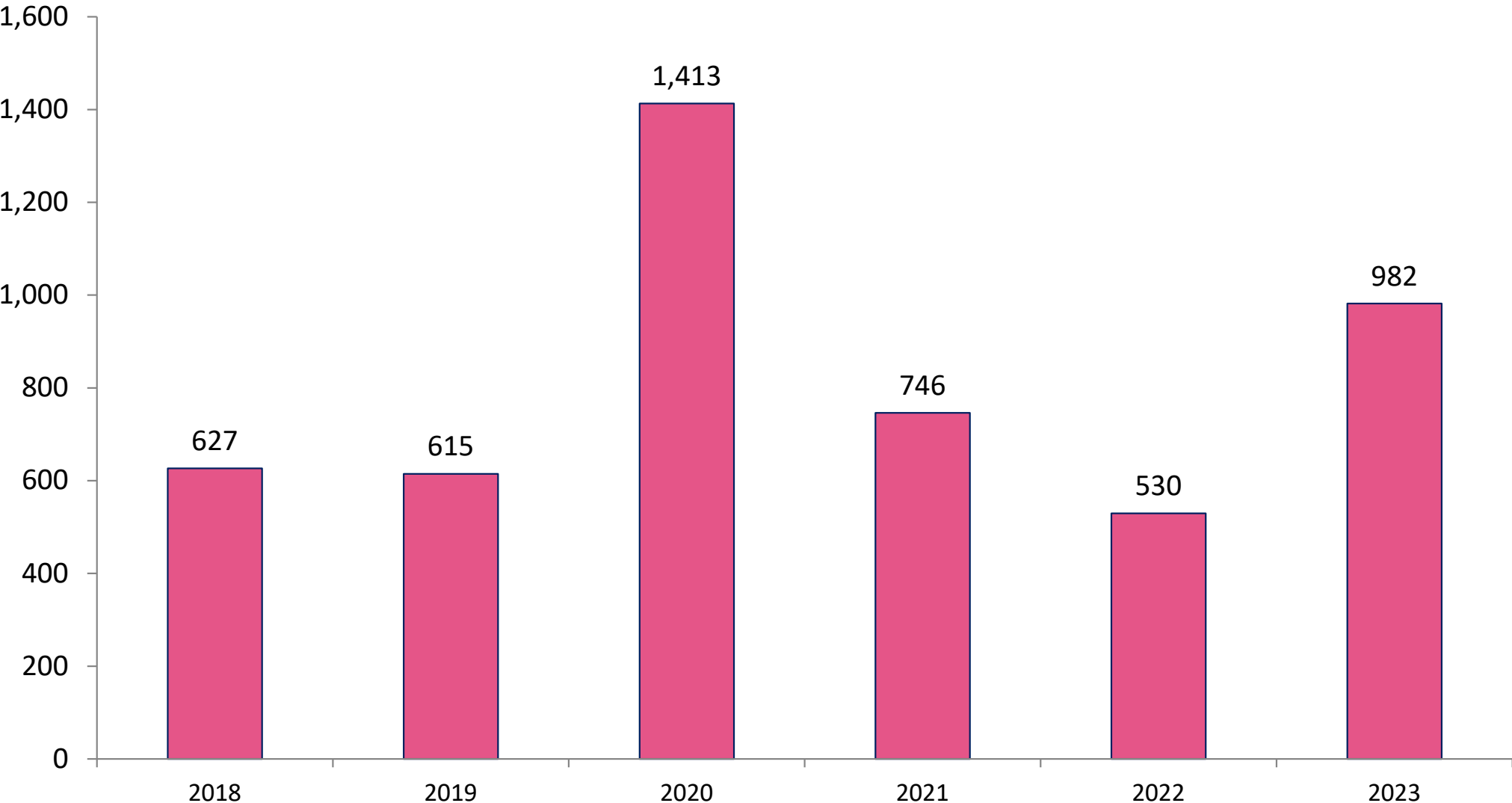

East Coast of Florida Landings, Jan.-Apr. 2018-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

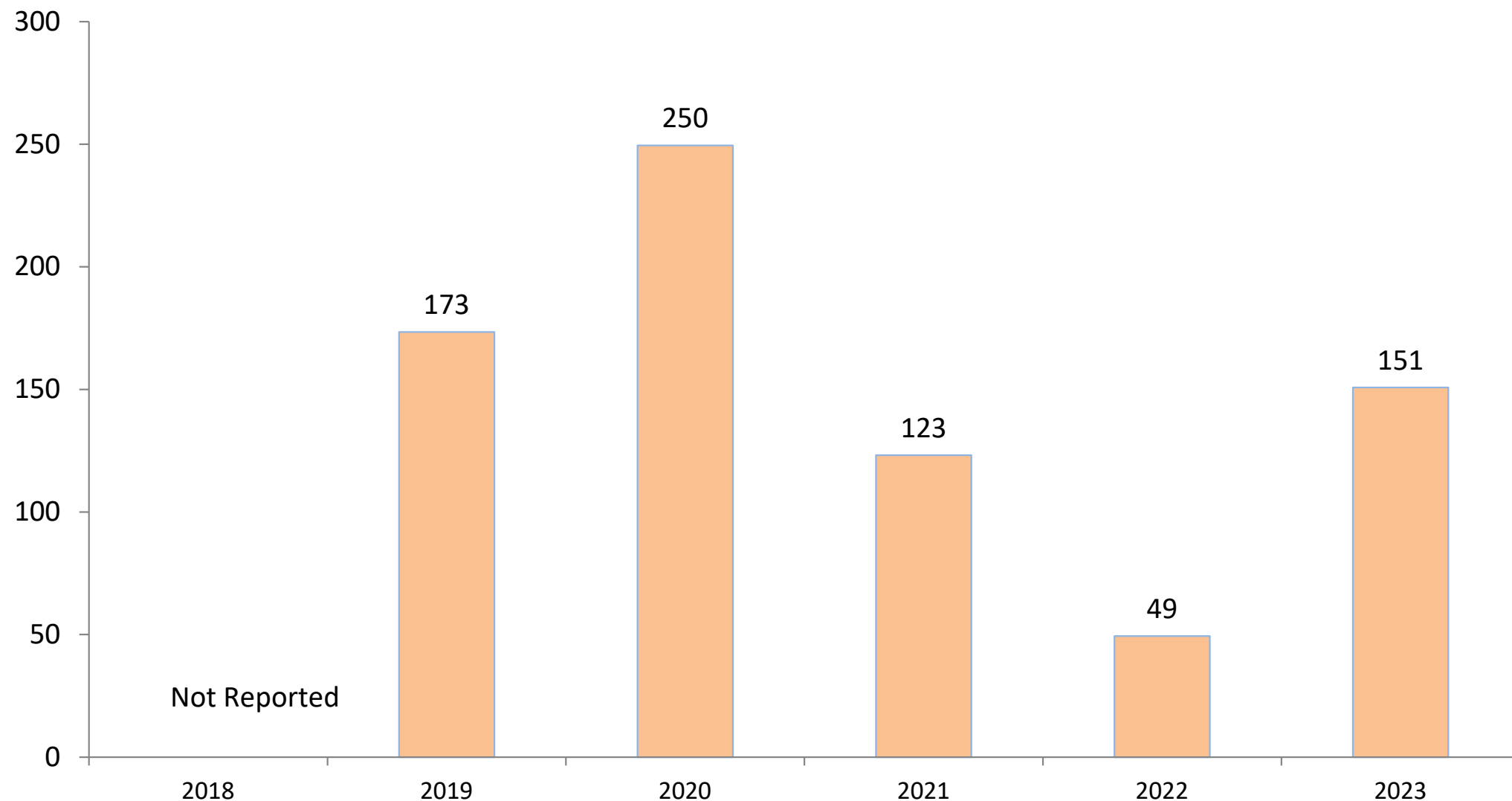


January-April average for the 2018-2022 period = 786,060 pounds

Georgia Landings, Jan.-Apr. 2018-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

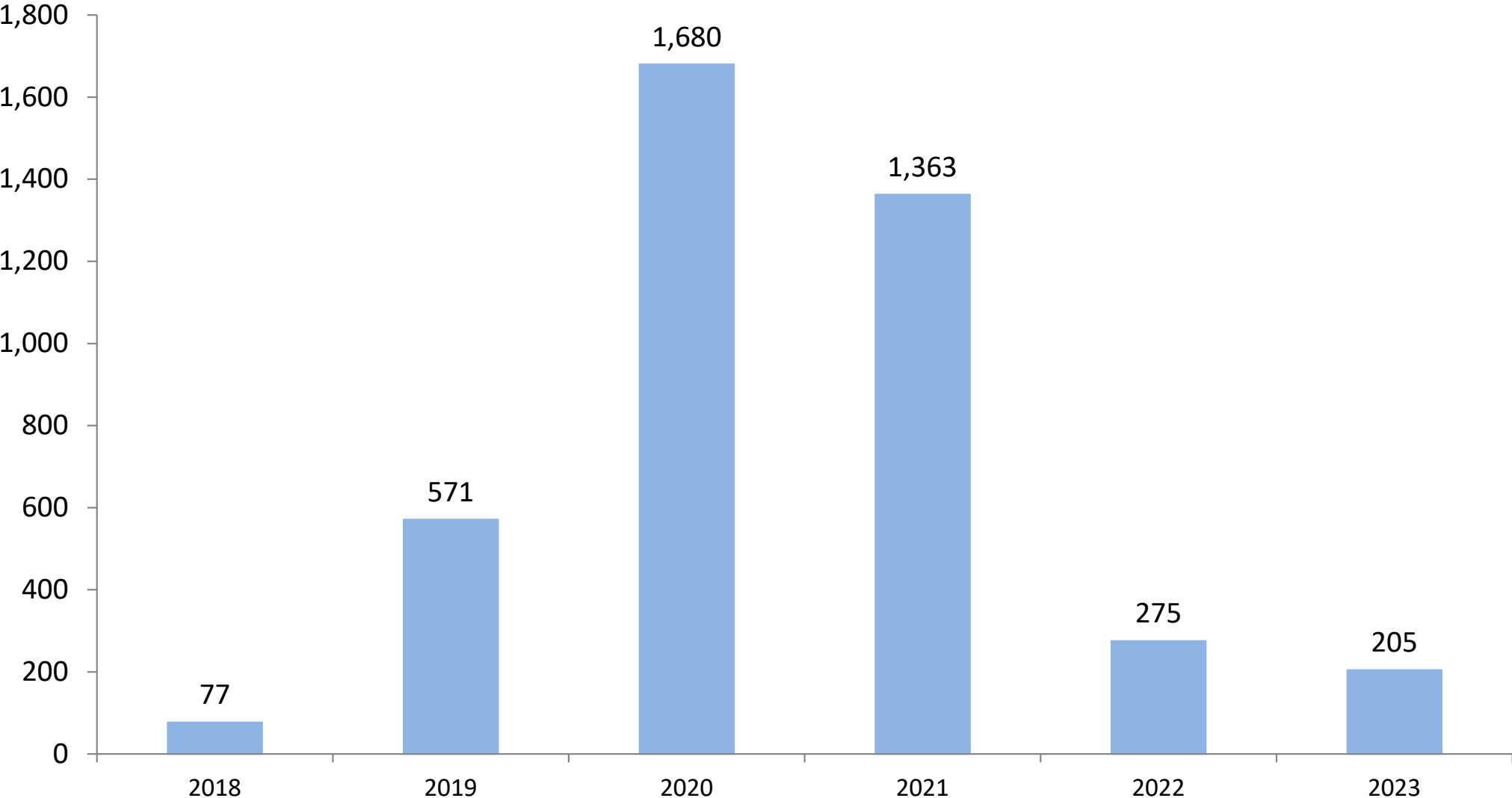


January-April average for the 2018-2022 period = 148,875 pounds

North Carolina Landings, Jan.-Apr. 2018-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

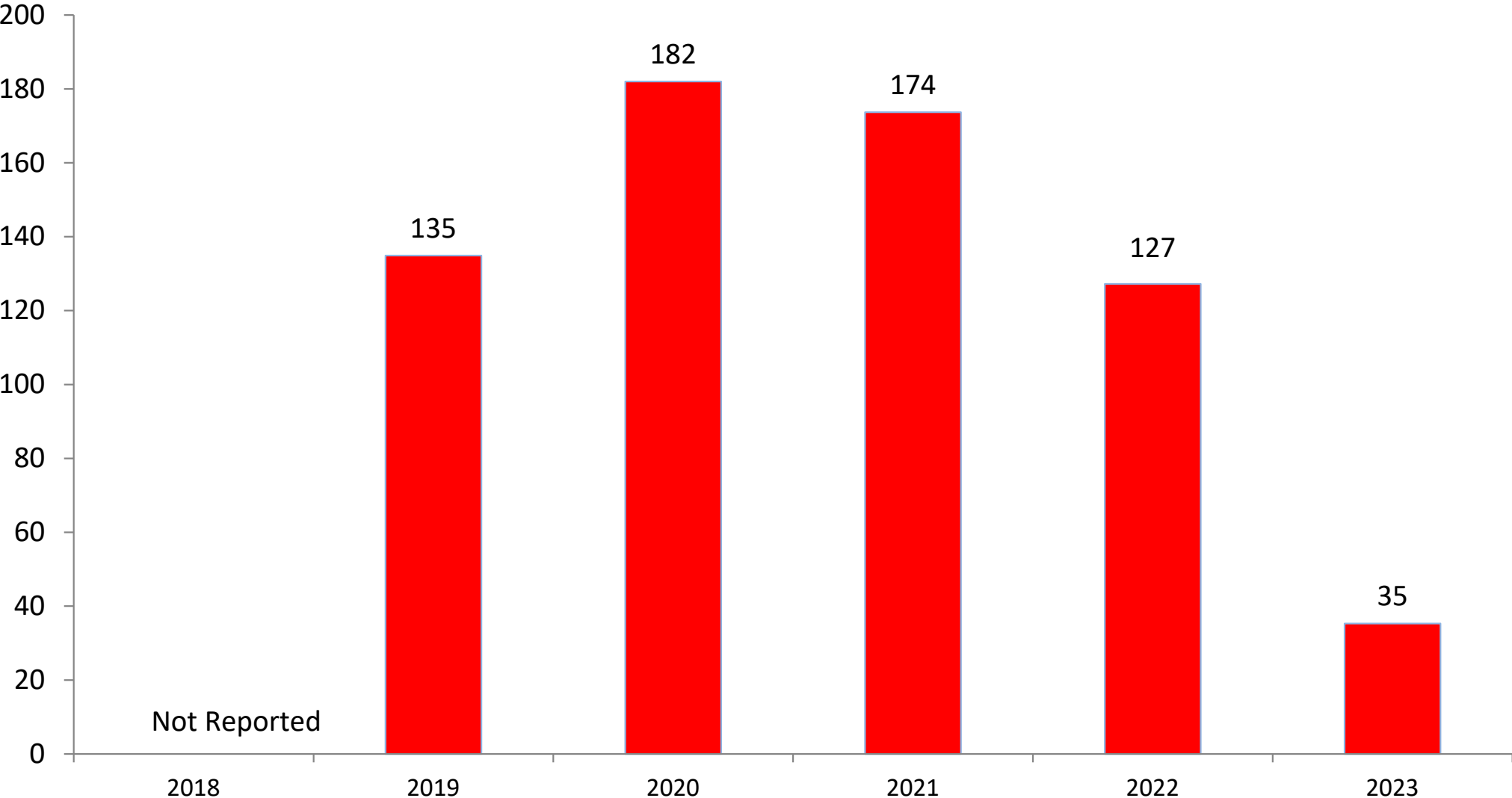


January-April average for the 2018-2022 period = 793,200 pounds

South Carolina Landings, Jan.-Apr. 2018-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

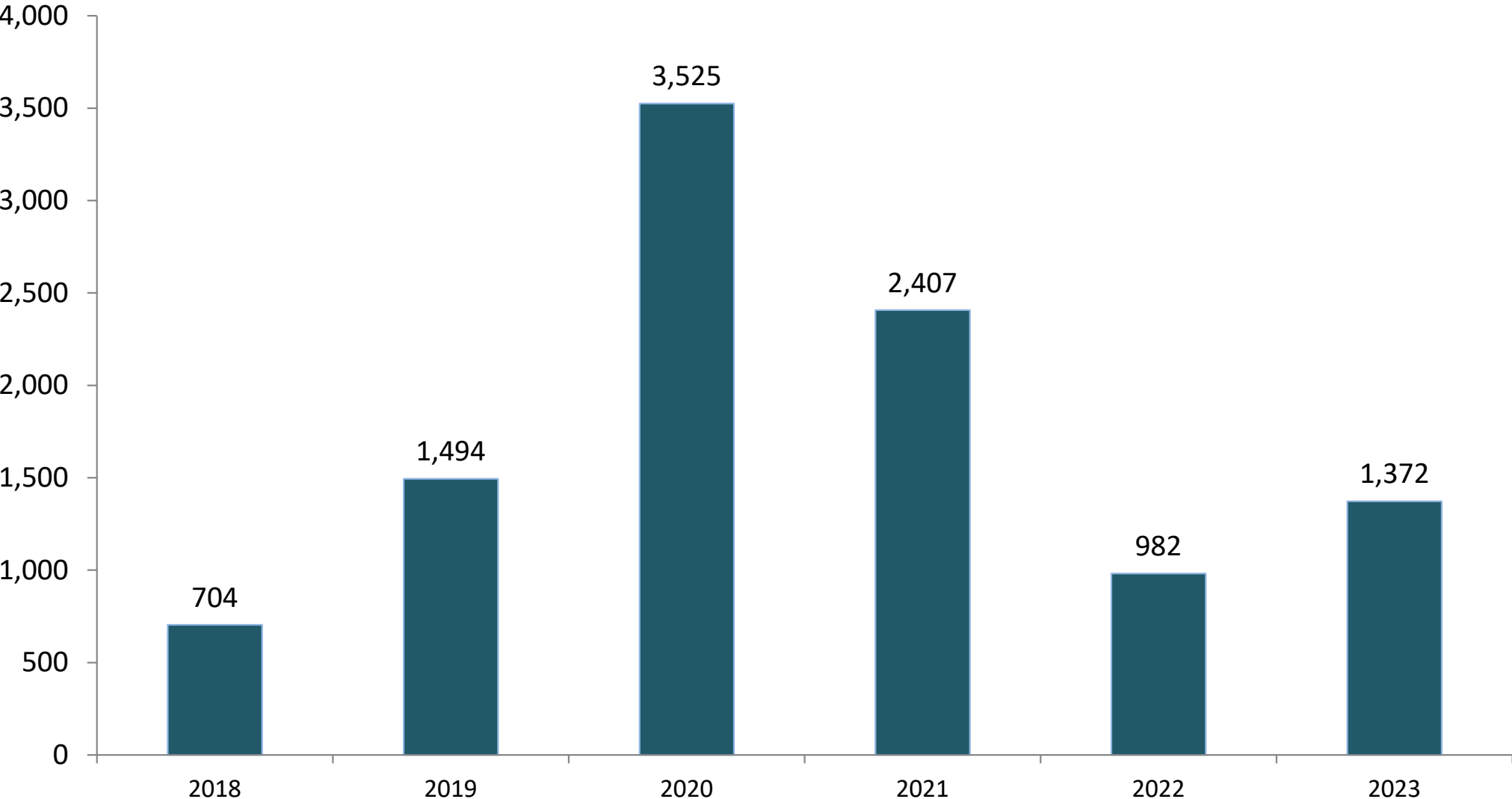


January-April average for the 2018-2022 period = 154,450 pounds

2023 Landings in South Atlantic Were 24.7% Below Historical Average

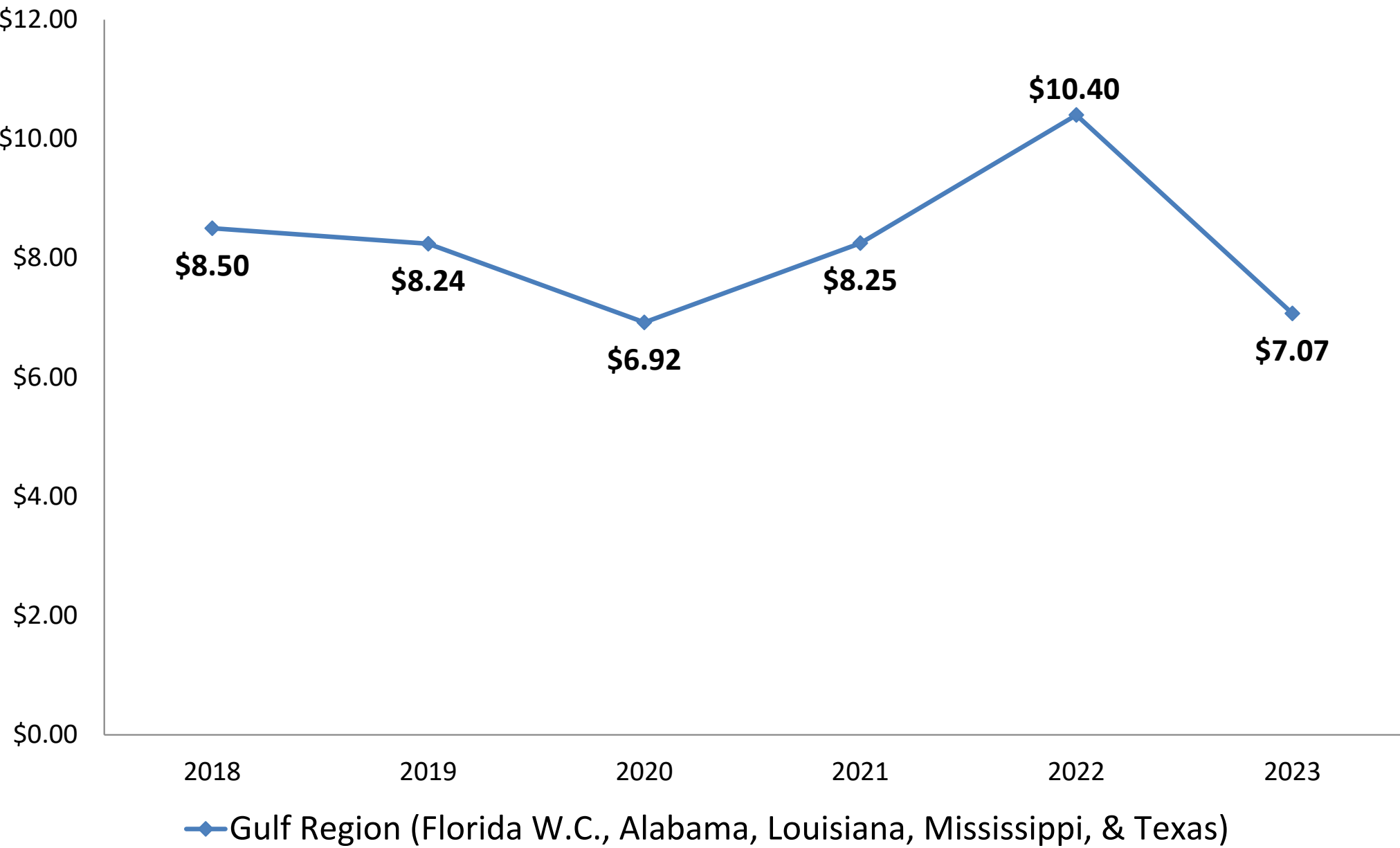


South Atlantic Landings, Jan.-Apr. 2018-2023 (thousands of pounds, HLSO-weight)

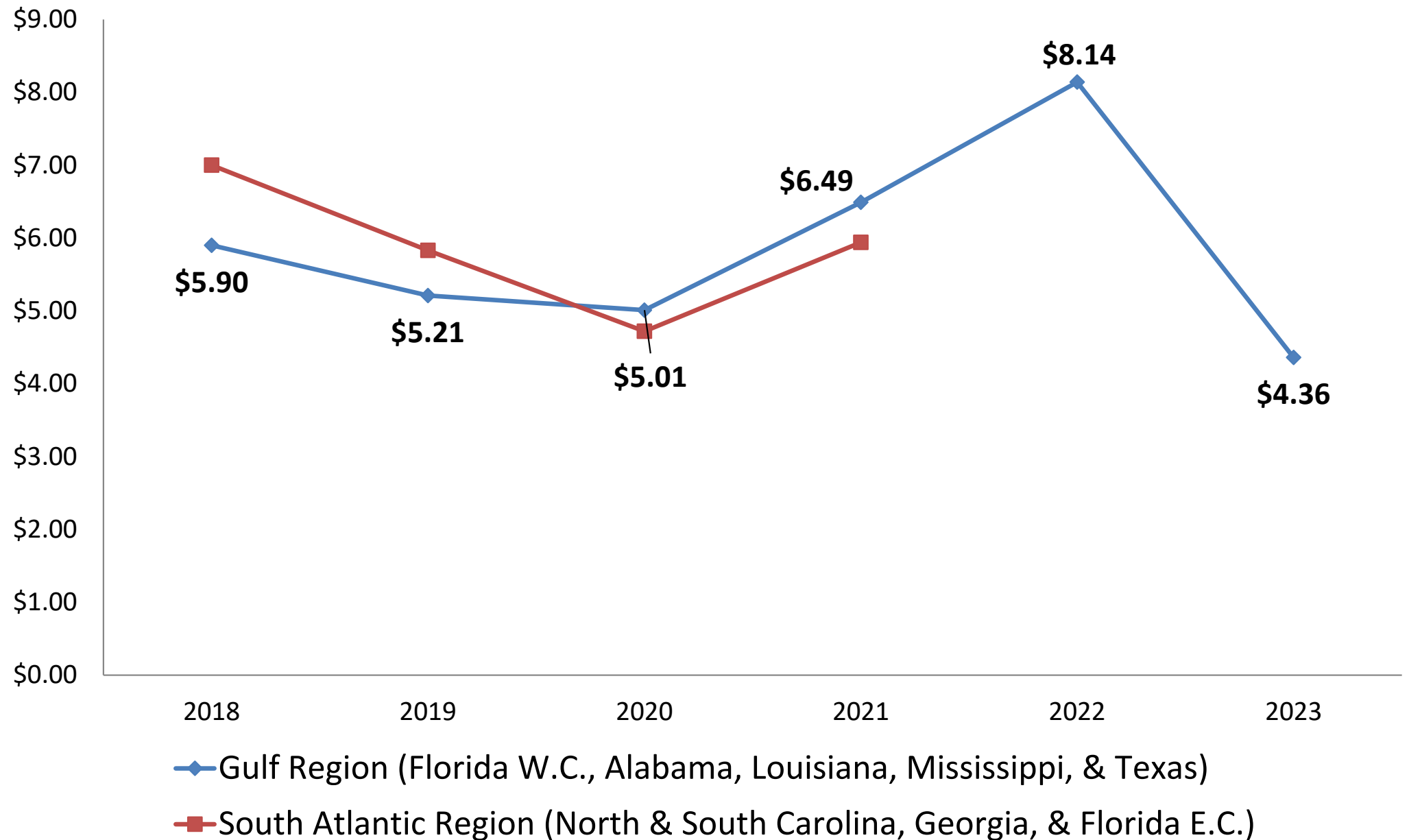

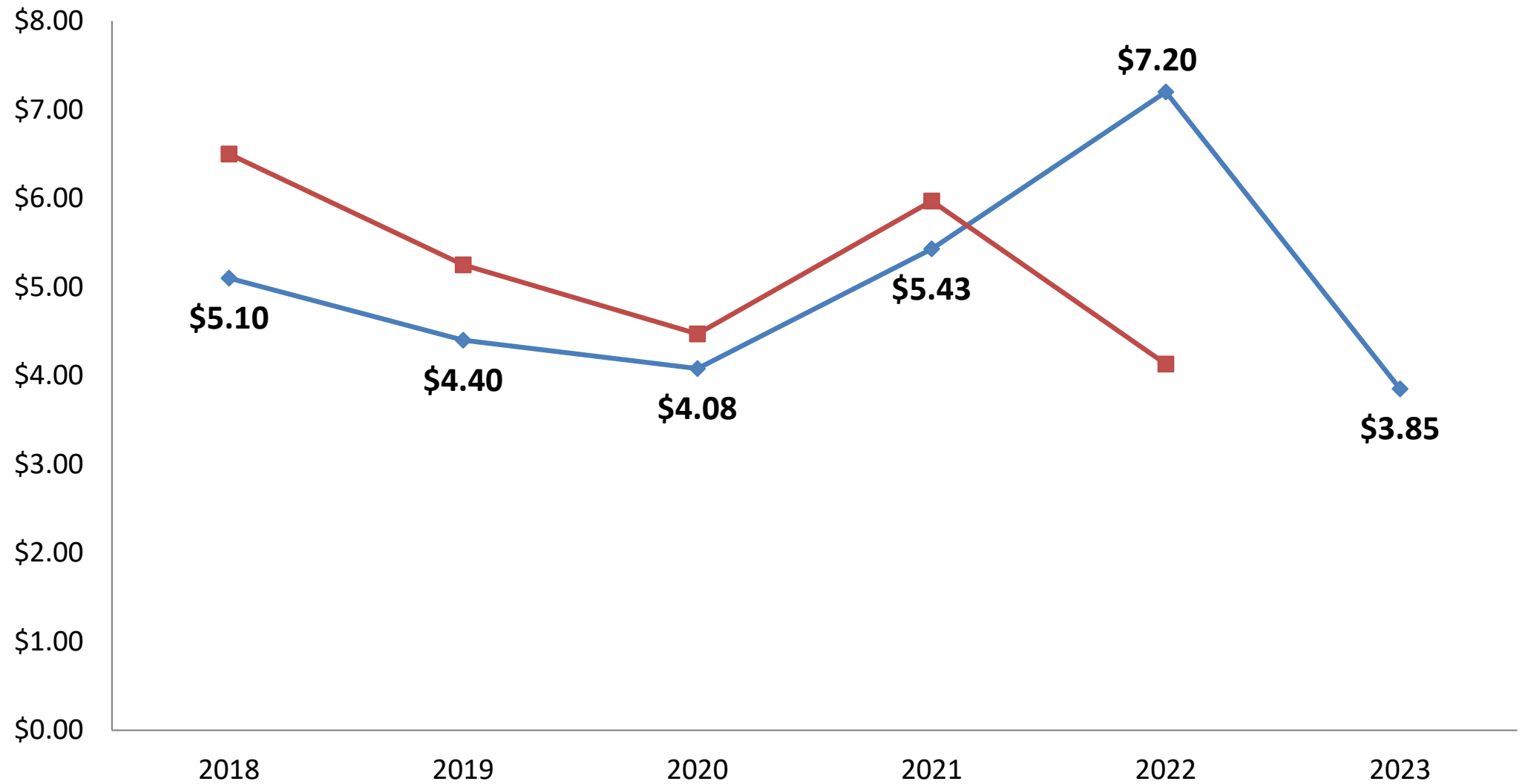
April Ex-Vessel Prices 2018-2023 (U15)



April Ex-Vessel Prices 2018-2023 (15/20)



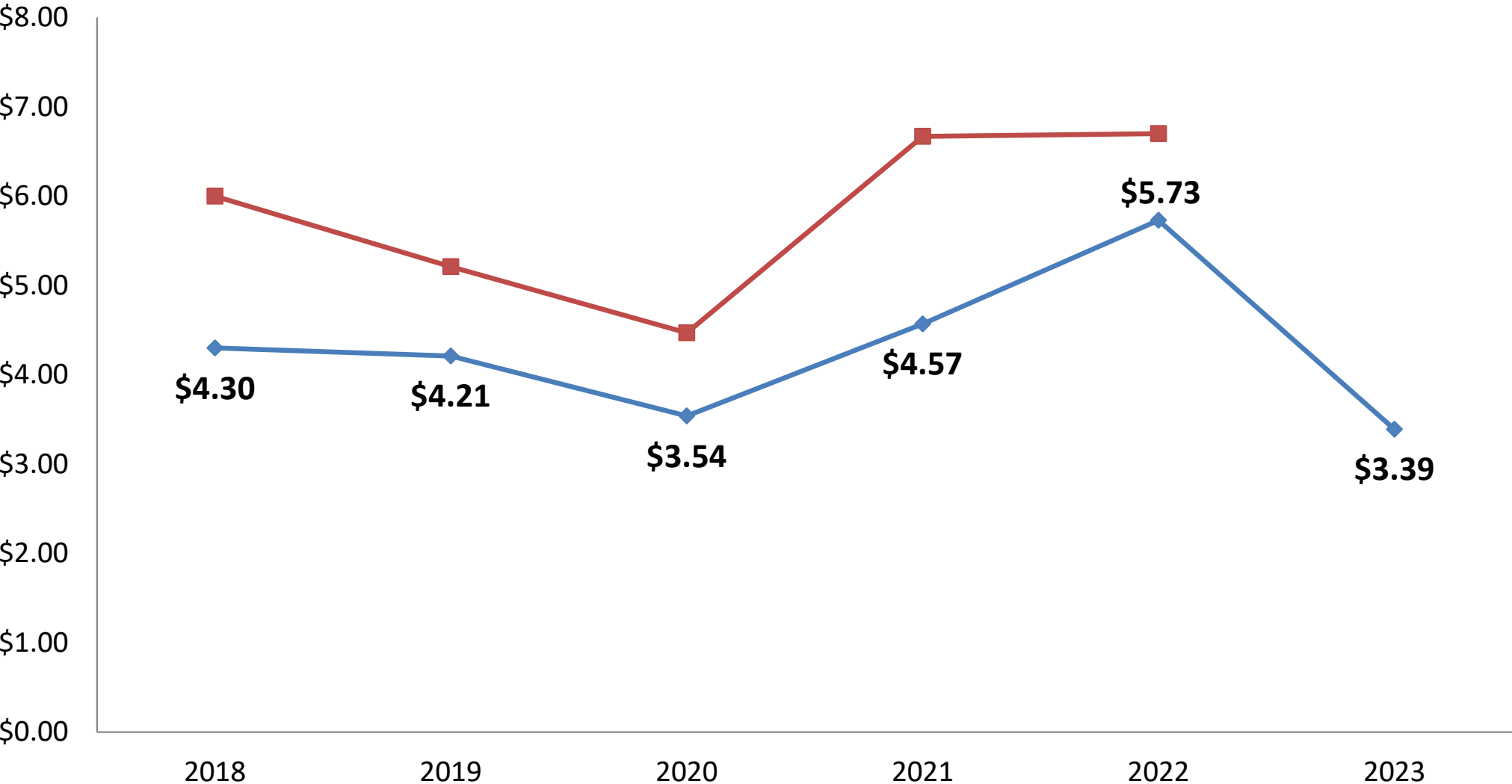

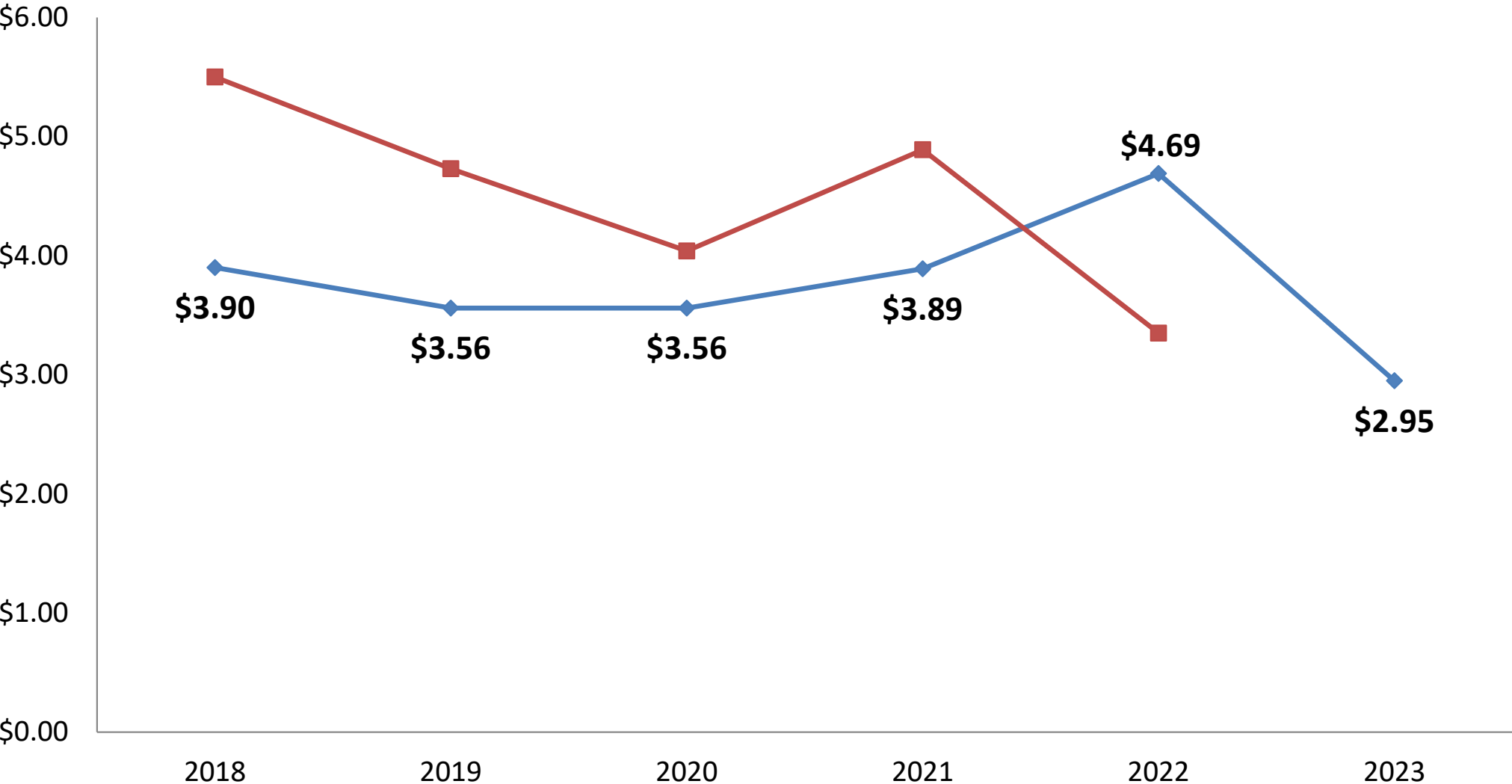

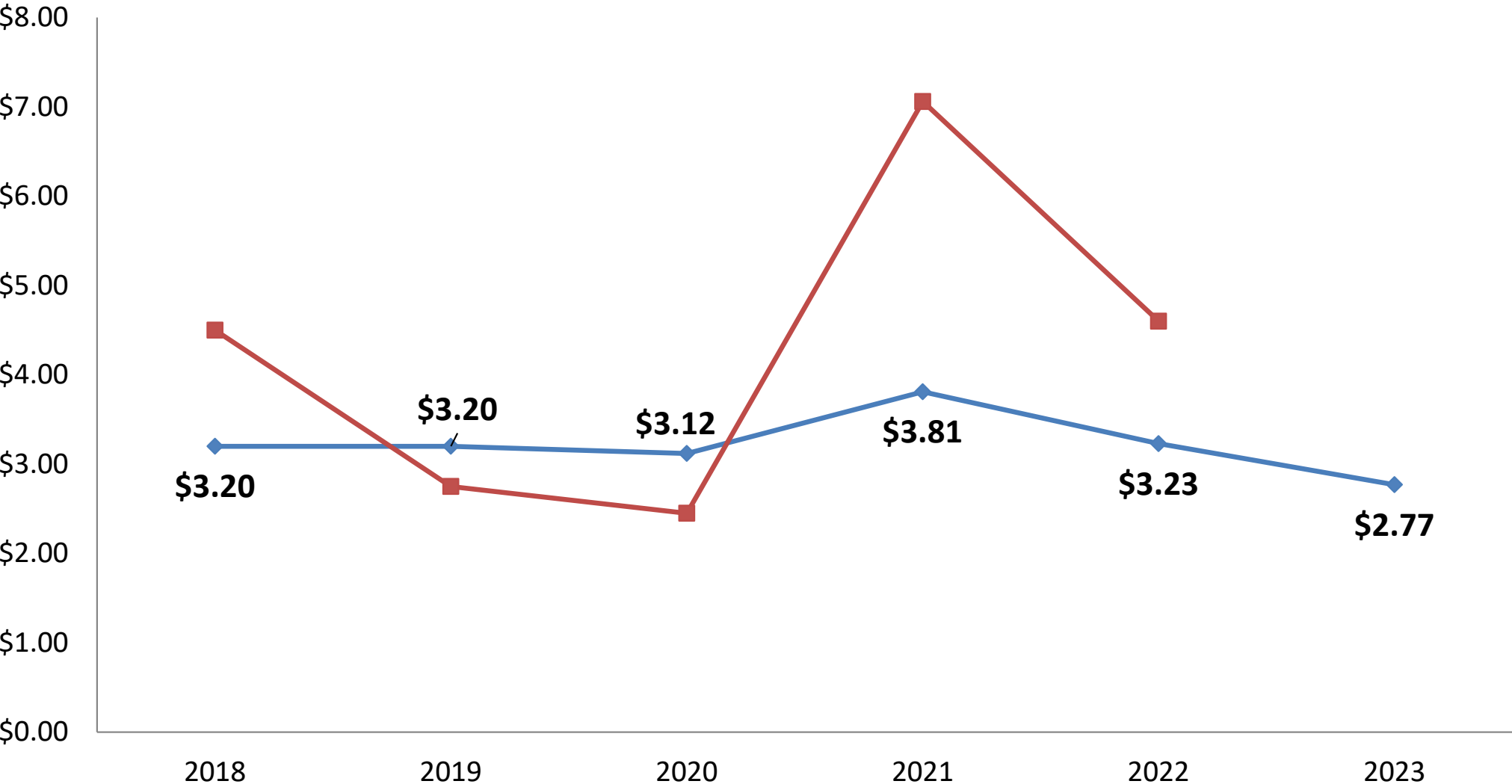

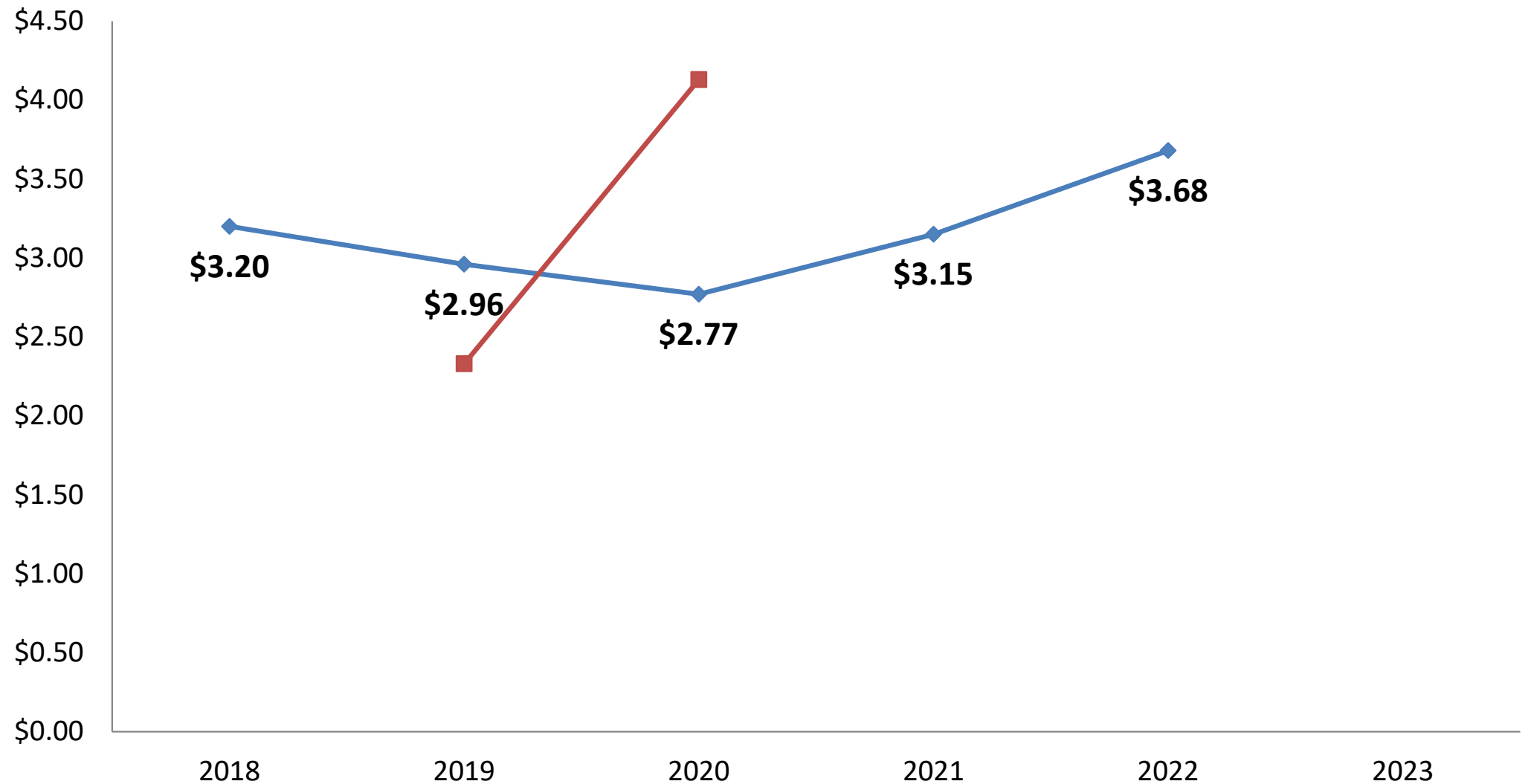
